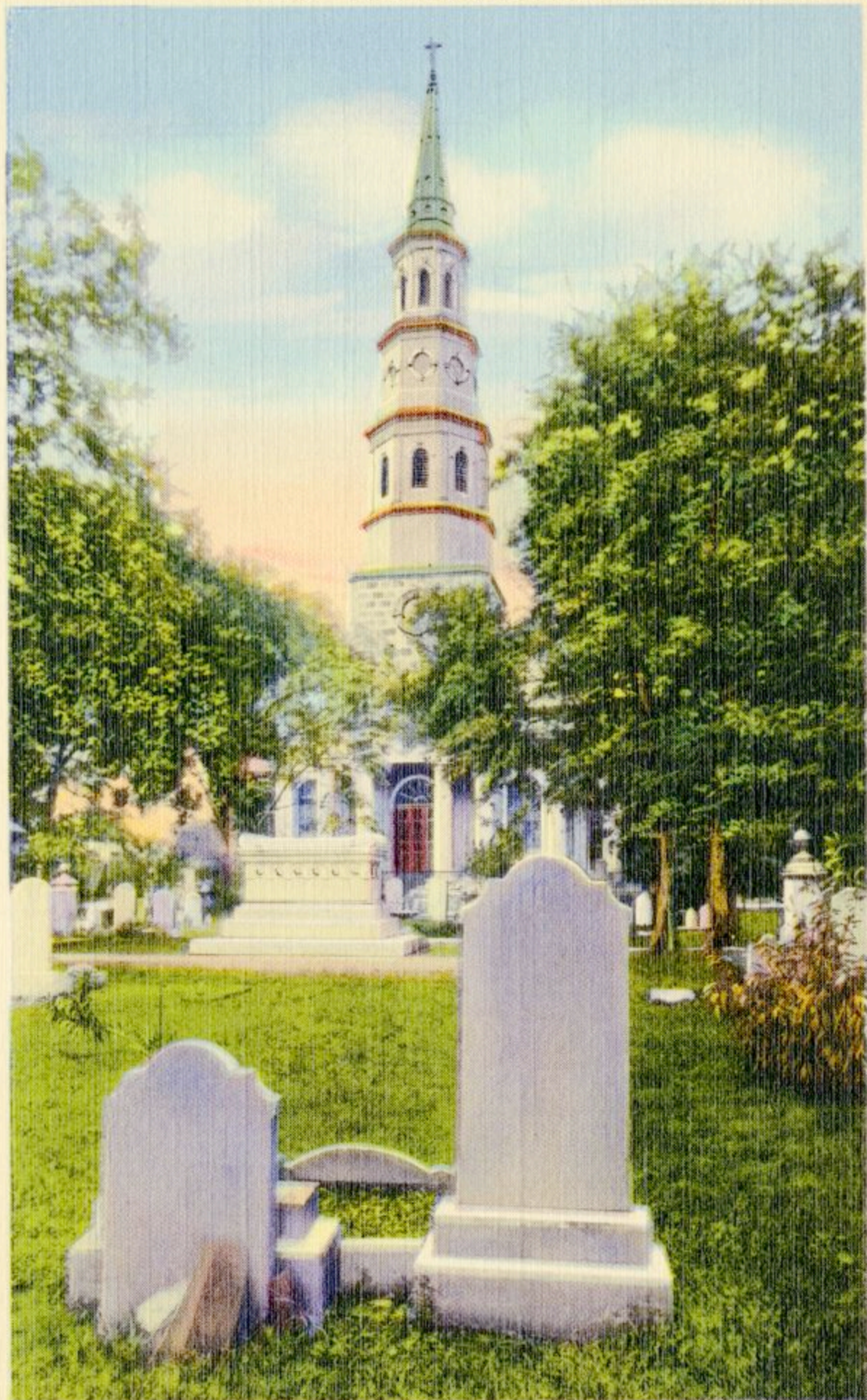


C. T. 29—St. Philip's Church, Charleston, S. C.

St. Philip's is known as the "Westminster of the South" because so many distinguished men of Colonial and Revolutionary days are buried in its graveyard. First building erected in 1681-2; second building in 1723 but this was destroyed in the great fire of 1835. Present building completed in 1838.
