## NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF BRIDGE, PLANS

## TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

- 1. Application has been made to the Department of the Army by the Florida State Road Department, Tallahassee, Florida 32301, for approval of the location and plans for a fixed bridge to replace the existing bridge across Apopka-Beauclaire Canal at State Road S-48 about 3 miles east of Astatula in Lake County, Florida. The proposed bridge would be in the same location as the existing bridge, which will be removed from the waterway. The new structure would be about 138 feet long and would provide a horizontal clearance of 37.0 feet between bents at the center span and minimum vertical clearances of 13.4 feet above extreme high water and 15.9 feet at normal flow water. See reverse side of this notice for location and plans of proposed work.
- 2. Application plans of this work may be seen at the office of the District Engineer, Corps of Engineers, 575 Riverside Avenue, Jacksonville, Florida.
- persons in order to assist in developing facts on which decision by the Corps of Engineers can be based. For accuracy and completeness of the record, all data in support of or in opposition to the proposed work should be submitted in writing setting forth sufficient detail to furnish a clear understanding of the reasons for support or opposition. While a Department of the Army permit merely expresses assent so far as the public rights of navigation are concerned information from interested persons on aspects of the proposed work other than navigation will be accepted and made a part of the record on the application. In cases of conflicting property rights, the Corps of Engineers cannot undertake to adjudicate rival claims. Protests or comments regarding the application under consideration should be submitted to the District Engineer, Corps of Engineers, P. O. Box 4970, Jacksonville, Florida, 32201, in time to be received on or before

  19 December 1966.
