Today, their firm employs 52 persons and occuples a large office bailding on East Central Boulevard overlooking Lake Eola. Tucker and Branham also has branch offlices in Winter Garden, Sanford and Groveland.

Fifty-six years after starting, both men report for duty every day, Branham works about half a day. Tucker puts in a full day. A few years amo they decided he would work three days a week, but he hasn't gotten around to that yet, except during hunting seston.

Through the years, both have distinguished themselves with their contributions to the community. For example, some longtime members of the Country Club of Orlando say that Branham saved the club from bankruptcy. He is a retired director of the Orange Bowl and chairman emeritus of the Central Flarida Blood Bark, which be has served since 1942. Tucker has been president of virtually every organization in which he has held membershlp, fncluding the Orlando Area Chamber of Commerce, Central Florida Fair and Florida Mortgege Bankers.
It may be sarprising these days to find two people who hive worked together - and have been friends - for 56 years.
"Oh, we've had disagreements, but we've always had sense enough to sit down and talk it out," said Branham:
"We're both tolorant, I guess, but Jack is more tolerant," wdded Tucker, grinning.
