I ENCLOSE DEEDS AND AS SOON AS RECEIVED FROM THE CLERKS OF THE DIFFERENT COURTS OF RECORD WILL FORWARD ABSTRACT OF TITLE SHOWING THE RECORDING OF CERTIFICATES EMBRACING THE LANDS DEEDED TO INGRA-HAM CHASE AND TRAFFORD, THIS COMPLETING THE CHAIN OF TITLE TO THE PURCHASERS. UPON APPLICATION TO THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE AT WASHING-TON THE PATENTS CAN BE ISSUED DIRECT TO THE TRUSTEES.
