When 2 was in Neigh School in 1940 mona $t$ Noddy gone me my Love Cedar chest. at that Tine girls called them their"Hoyse chest. Mama crocheted me a perfectly beautiful Bed Spread That was put in and is still in use Today -

Daddy wonted To put something in it that was made by him. He served in the first world war and was a member of The American Legion. The Legion tut was on the Lake front and in front of it was a cannon from the first wosed was and Whew scrap metal was needed during the second world war the Legionnaires dismantled it
and sent the metal ports To be used in the War. Woody got one of the wooden spokes from one of the wheels and made me a rolling pin to put in the "Hope Chest",

After the War former +2 were married Sept. 11, 1946. The rolling pin come out of The cedar $c$ hent and for the lost 57 years has been in constant use as "Southern Biscuits ore James favorite food.

Often when In rolling out Biscuits or Pie crust 2 think of Poddy and remember how proud hewas when he put the Toweling pin in my "Hope Chest"
