Mr. Terry Thomas - Director

Terry Thomas returns to the Orlando Gay Chorus after enjoying the honor of serving as the accompanist for our first Pride Concert in June of 1990, and as interim director for the Pride Concert 1995, DANCE THE NIGHT AWAY. With a Master's Degree in Music from Indiana State University, Terry has taught in the Midwest and in Kuwait, as the Performing Arts Coordinator for the American School of Kuwait, where he also served as the director of the British Choral Society. He arranged, did backup vocals, and played keyboards for a Department of Defense Entertainment Tour. Orlando theater-goers may remember him from performances in LOVE! VALOR! COMPASSION!, SINGIN' IN THE RAIN, and OKLAHOMA!, and he was the musical director for last year's production of ANNIE at the Civic Theater of Central Florida. Regional audiences have seen him musically direct at the Riverside Theater in Vero Beach, Florida, and for the Southwestern regional tour of BY GEORGE!, a revue featuring the compositions of George Gershwin. He also performed in professional theater (musicals, of course!) outside Chicago, in PUMP BOYS AND DINETTES, and A FUNNY THING HAPPENED ON THE WAY TO THE FORUM. After working at Universal Studios Florida as a vocal coach, his current joy is at Disney's Animal Kingdom, as the Performance/Theming Coach. This is for my parents, by whose example I can only hope to achieve their level of love and understanding.

Kathy studied music at the University of Northern Colorado. She has worked with the Wekiva Players theater troupe, is a free-lance singer and instrumentalist, and a performer with the Dickens Carolers. She teaches piano and flute in her home and at the Academy of Music and Theater in Winter Garden. She owns her own entertainment company appropriately named Take Out Entertainment. Kathy has played piano and keyboard for many OGC performances since 1995. She has a husband, Dan, and a daughter, Anna.






