





A graduate of Ohio State University, he holds degrees in music education, vocal performance, and music education for the exceptional learner. Aubrey has performed with and directed the Columbus Light Opera Company, the Columbus Symphony, the Darmstadt and Frankfurt opera companies, the Cleveland Orchestra, and the Kinley Players. He was a recipient of a Presidential Award for Musical Excellence and he has worked with several local theaters include the Ice House Theater, Civic Theater, and The Winter Garden Players. Aubrey owns and directs the Academy of Music & Theater in Winter Garden and he regularly conducts seminars in vocal technique and vocal health for music groups in the Orlando area including the Catholic diocese and the Orange, Seminole, and Osceola County school systems.


Christopher M. Fecteau, Accompanist








Paul R. Ericson Memorial AIDS Fund
