Dear Sir,

Your letter of yesterday to Mr. Thomsow was read at the Board meeting today but the Report having been already revised issued to the Shareholders with notice of meeting, further alterations could not be considered.

I am instructed to forward you the following extract from the minutes of the Board meeting held to day viz:

"The Board considered the necessity for granting a Power of Attorney to cover sales of the newly acquired lands in Polk, Santa, Hernando, Brevard & Volusia Counties, the present Power of Attorney held by Mr. Sanford only applying to the lands originally purchased from him, and it was resolved

that

"In order to prevent delays, it is desirable to vest
the usual power to sign deeds in the Agents of
the Company, resident in Florida, who already
possess full powers to enter into agreements for
sales which bind the Company, and accordingly
that the Trustees be requested to give a new Power
of Attorney to Mess^{rs} Trafford & Beardall to cover
sales of all the property belonging to the Company
in the State of Florida, cancelling the Power previously
given to Mr. Sanford"
