The amount of Debenture
Interest payable in London on 1st Jan
amounts to £166 2 against which
there will be in Bank on that date

about £855., so that a remittance
of £1000 now would put us — here
on a sound footing and enable
us to reduce Mess^{rs} Gray Dawes & Co's
loan of £3,900 with future remittances
The suggested loan of \$20,000 from
the Manayunk Bank would only
enable us to pay off Mess^{rs} Gray
at once, which would not be an object
unless there should be a saving in
interest and assurance of renewals
for such time as the Company
