about £855, so that a remittance

us to reduce Mess^{rs} Gray Dawes Co's
loan of £3,900 with future remittances
The suggested loan of \$20,000 from
the Manayunk Bank would only
enable us to pay off Mess^{rs} Gray
at once, which would not be an object
unless there should be a saving in
interest and assurance of renewals
for such time as the Company
