Known also as Florida's underwater fairyland, Silver Springs is really a subterranean river springing from the earth through a vast cavern 65 feet wide, 12 feet high at its mouth and lying 50 feet below the surface of the circular basin which forms the head of the springs and the source of Silver River.

Proclaiming that it is to the South what Niagara Falls is to the East and Grand Canyon is to the West, millions of amazed visitors insist that it is one great natural attraction everyone should see. For here at Silver Springs nature has drawn aside the curtain of mystery that shrouds most waters and, through the magic of "water as clear as air," reveals a living panorama of a world unknown to those who have never seen beneath its surface.



#### GLASS BOTTOM BOAT RIDE

Your boat will hardly have glided away from the dock when the guide will point out to you the MAMMOTH ROCK LEDGE

BIG SPRING AND ENDLESS CAVERN from which pours an average of 550,000,000 gallons of water every 24 hours.

RECEPTION HALL - Spectral rays scintillating upon the sand-limestone walls.

BRIDAL CHAMBER - The legendary and fathomless crevice which emits a filmy veil of shell in a never-ending stream. This stream is 81 feet deep.

LADIES' PARLOR - A thousand rainbows mirrored against a background of alabaster pink (62 feet across).

DEVIL'S KITCHEN - Springs bubbling charcoal, giving the appearance of smouldering campfires.

PREHISTORIC BONES - Remains of the giant mastodon that once roamed Florida are clearly seen at a depth of 36 feet near fascinating GEYSER SPRING.

BLUE GROTTO - A pool of ethereal blue, 41 feet deep, and clearer than the air you breathe. Trick fish often parade in military formation.

TURTLE MEADOW - Turtle herds graze upon unique woolly moss that covers the bottom at this place.

GARDEN OF EDEN - Where coral and silk ferns of gorgeous colorings and beautiful markings vie with waxlike bridal wreaths to form a fascinating picture.

THE SUNKEN GARDENS - Where one sees the most interesting subaquatic plants on display anywhere on earth, actually resembling forests viewed from an airplane.


FISHERMAN'S PARADISE - Where the fish play football. CATFISH HOTEL - Watch for the manager.


bus and taxi service readily available.


