## Children's Society Asks For Summer Homes For Family

JACKSONVILLE, Apr. 25—(Special)—How about giving one or two homeless boys a vacation at your home this summer?

The Children's Home Society of Florida—with receiving homes at Jacksonville, Miami, Pensacola and Lakeland—is making its annual appeal to the people of Florida for summer vacation homes for its big family of homeless boys and girls, but is particularly anxious this year for vacation homes for boys from 10 to 15 years of age.

Each year for the past 10 years the society has been placing its homeless and orphan children in carefully selected family homes for the summer vacation period—giving joy to scores of boys and girls who are eager to get away from the routine rules and regulations of the receiving homes, and many families have had the satisfaction of bringing a new experience and much happiness to themselves.

All that the Home Society asks of the families who offer their homes to these boys and girls is that they be people of unquestioned good character—that they will treat the children and discipline them just as they would their own youngsters—and that they be willing to either accept the child at the end of the summer, or that they will bear the expense of having the child brought to them and later returned to his home.

The Home Society expects these boys and girls to be willing to do odd jobs in return for their vacation privileges—and will furnish each child a reasonable supply of clothing for the summer. All information will gladly be given by Marcus C. "Daddy" Brown, state superintendent of the Children's Home Society, 48 Commercial Building, Jacksonville, or secured from any one of the society's receiving homes at Jacksonville, Miami, Lakeland or Pensacola. No children under six years of age are available for vacation homes—and the children need no vacation homes.
