Actually, the 5,000 immigration certificates represent the normal quota for a 15-month period. The issue of certain detention camps will be the first step in the process of dissolving the post-war illegal immigrants who have been shipped to the island of Cyprus.

The British are now shipping more than 5,000 and 6,000 Jews on Cyprus at present.
