Reds In Sevastopol Stand Firm Against Land And Air Blows

Bitter Tank Battle Is In 14th Day As Wild Fight Occurs In Scorching Heat

(By Associated Press.) In Moscow, it was reported today that the German air force is pounding Sevastopol by land and air, but the navy base is standing firm.

Meantime, the RAF shipped German tanks today and landed them on the beach. The British warned French coastal residents to move inland.

The fury of the Nazi air assault was indicated by last night's communiqué which listed 12 German planes destroyed in the week ended yesterday against 13 Soviet losses. In the absence of large scale aerial activity on the other side, the enormous toll presumably was paid by the Germans in their renewed efforts to knock out Sevastopol.

The big naval base has been under siege since last October and after the fall of the Kerch peninsula to the Nazis last month retained the last Soviet-held Crimean bastion.

The Germans claiming a victory for themselves and the British from Sevastopol, a report saying that in the last week the Russians lost 12 planes to only 20 German craft.

This apparently supreme effort to reduce the long and stubbornly resisting naval base apparently is accounted for the enormous toll of German planes.

Up and down the long front fighting of local importance continues in a scorching heat.
