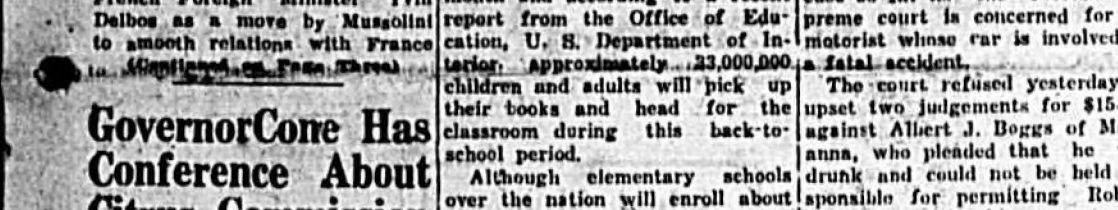

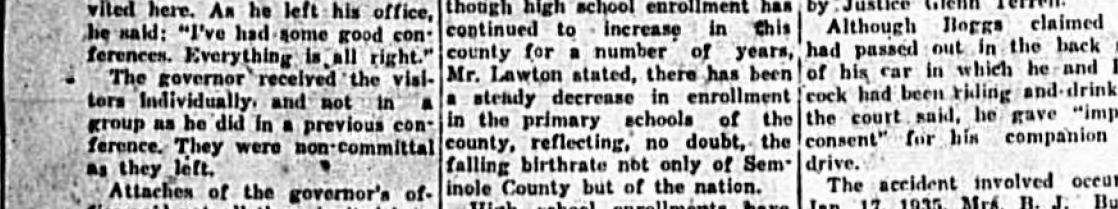

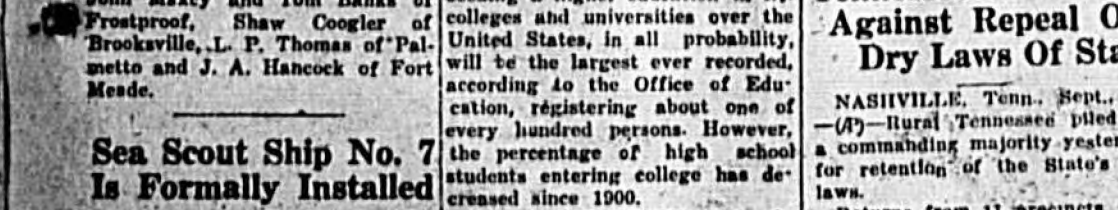

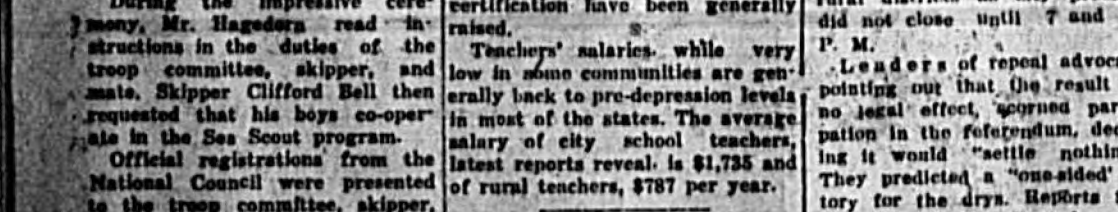

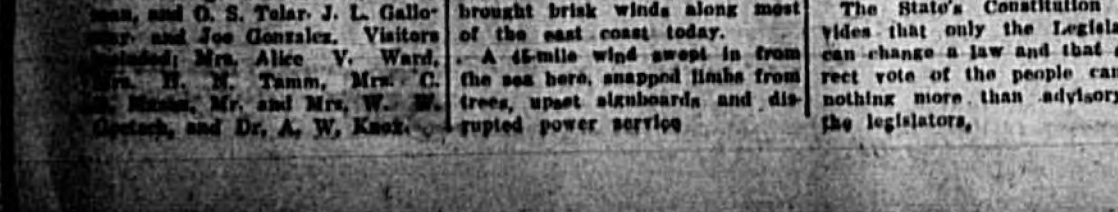

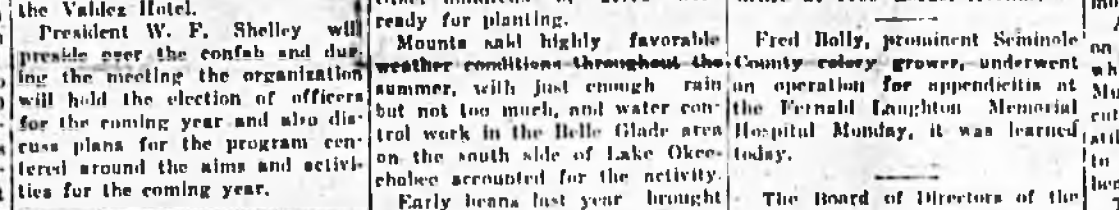

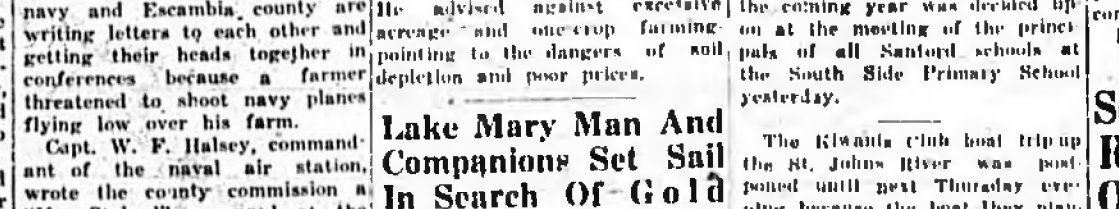

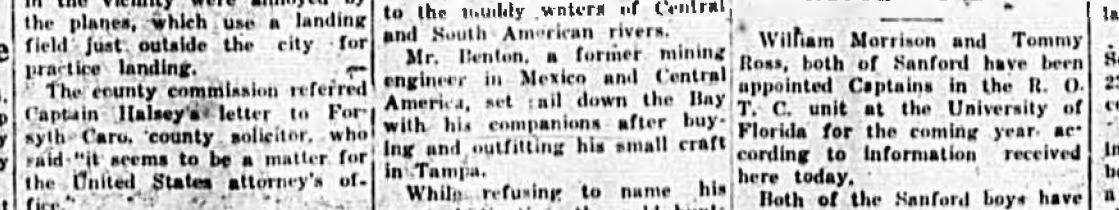
LARGE FALL CROP IS PREDICTED FOR EVERGLADES AREA - More than five hundred acres of beans are already planted...



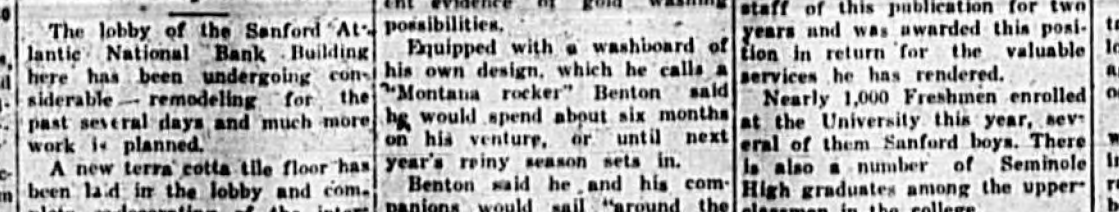

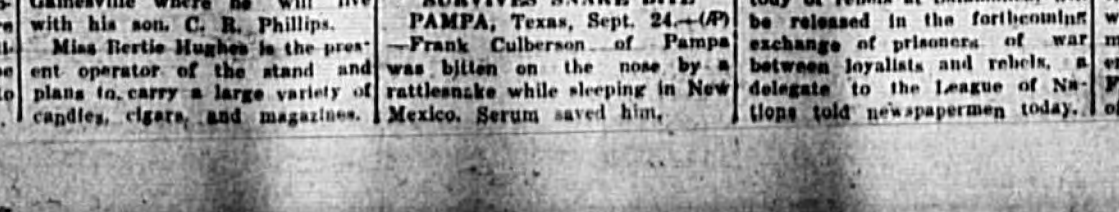
