cheaply enough for ordinary citizens to own them. Mass ownerahip made the infant industry valuable as an adver-
tialng medium. Television has come a long way in a few a ghort years.
Great credit should go to Anerican scientiats. promotern and Investors. But it slould not be forgooten that men of
other countries made important contributions.
