N. Y. U. VIOLETS HOLD SPOTLIGHT IN GRID CIRCLES

Violets Have Whipped Eight Straight Opponents and Only Ten Points Scored Against Them This Season

NEW YORK, Nov. 18.—(AP)—The fact that Gene Tunney has no written contract to fight for Tex Rickard is regarded in boxing circles as an indication that he probably will defend his newly won heavyweight crown next summer in a battle promoted by Humbert Fugazy.

The lack of a written agreement between Tunney and Rickard has just been disclosed. Tunney, in a conference with Fugazy, expressed his willingness to fight for that promoter if satisfactory terms could be arranged. Rickard admitted he had no more than a verbal agreement with Tunney under which the champion was to meet the winner of an elimination series this winter among leading contenders.

Fugazy will discuss the matter further with Tunney next Tuesday, and the champion will explain his reasons for splitting with Rickard, Fugazy says. Tunney is reported dissatisfied with the financial returns of his fight with Dempsey in Philadelphia when he received \$204,000.

The original agreement called for Tunney to receive a flat guarantee of 15 per cent of the gate receipts, which would have amounted to \$300,000, but a new arrangement was made shortly before the fight.

Tunney May Fight Next Summer For Promoter Fugazy

NEW YORK, Nov. 18.—(AP)—While the unshrinking Violets of New York City were westward bound today to play Nebraska at Lincoln Saturday, Harvard and Yale buckled down to final drills for the last of the traditional Big Three conflicts. Interest in the East in week-end football centers in these two games.

After yesterday's workout, 3,000 students jimmied the Harvard union to pledge their faith in the team and roar their approval of Arnold Horween's announcement that he would coach Harvard again next year.

Yale is juggling a backfield around in search for the strongest combination. Rooters have not given up hope that Caldwell, feature back of early season games, will be in the starting lineup after injuries that have kept him on the sidelines for five weeks.

Little hope of rugged competition is seen on the remainder of Saturday's card as many eleven meet minor foes. Fordham-Georgetown and West Virginia-Carnegie Tech alone offer possibilities of tense competition. Lafayette opposed the battered Lehigh forces, Syracuse meets Niagara, Brown takes on New Hampshire and Holy Cross tackles Boston University. Army and Navy sharpen their weapons for the annual service title on Nov. 27, with tryouts against Uralnus and Loyola.

From advance accounts the field will be the best that has ever faced the post in any section of the south.

Theodore Guy, world champion three year old pacing gelding is entered and will be driven by Sep Palin, veteran driver and trainer. This animal stepped the fast mark of 2:02 3-4 at Lexington as a three year old, a record that has not again been equalled. It will be his first start at Seminola.

came through to win her two heats in great style. Jack Toddington, who furnished a bit of competition in the first two heats, got up in time to capture second money by winning the third heat from Dorothy Gish, who placed in all three. The hecrowd was considerably larger yesterday and new arrivals are helping. The days are expected to be filled with hundreds of followers who are coming in here to see the wait the opening of the season, which will close upon the heels of the pullers.

RECORD CROWDS TO WITNESS BIG TEN FINALE

Minneapolis Stadium Will be Packed Next Saturday on the Occasion of Its 2nd Year With Wolverine Team

CHICAGO, Nov. 18.—(AP)—The eastern conference football season is just about over except for the playoffs, but Big Ten schools are having a record-breaking volume of spectators at Saturday's finale.

Every available inch in Minneapolis stands has been claimed for the game, looking for a battle in the second clash of the season between the Gophers and Michigan, one of the two undefeated eleven in the conference.

Fans stood in line through the night when the final block of 1,000 went on sale.

At Illinois Zuppke's men seem to draw a capacity crowd to watch their game with Ohio State. Chicago looks for one of the biggest crowds of the year. Both teams are in the midst of a late season change to radical shift in strategy, stressing the aerial game, and anything can happen in their meeting.

Half of Iowa turned out to overflow the Hawkeye Stadium once again in fall, and there are prospects of an approximation of the crowd when the Iowans seek Saturday to poll undefeated Northwestern's services of tying Michigan.

The Hoosier war between Indiana and Purdue is a crowd breaker attraction and there, as elsewhere, the final appearance of similar stars is a feature of the closing days of the season.

Notre Dame closed a mid-western year simultaneously with the conference teams, Rockne entraining Drake before starting the swing which takes the contenders of Army first to Carnegie Tech and then to Southern California.

MERCER TO PLAY OGLETHORPE FOR GRID SUPREMACY

Saturday's Game Will Determine State Championship of Georgia; Petrels Have Beaten Georgia Tech

Mercer's football team, which ran rough shod over the light Rollins eleven in Sanford on Armistice Day, will charge the Oglethorpe Petrels in the classic feature of Georgia Saturday.

Atlanta will be the meeting grounds of the two old time enemies for what Mercer supporters say will be the game that will determine the state championship of Georgia. Oglethorpe beat Georgia Tech in the first game of the season, 7 to 6, and later defeated Furman which had trimmed Georgia.

A feature of the game Saturday is that Atlanta, the state's capital, will witness all four of the Empire State's college football teams in action on successive Saturdays. The Georgia Bulldogs nosed out Georgia Tech last Saturday in Atlanta, 14 to 13.

Several Mercer players will be playing their last college football game against the Petrels Saturday. Captain John Parks, who played the entire game against Rollins, will don the helmet for the last time. Denver Fleming and Fred Forrester, centers and Kay Tipton, guards will shake the dirt of the gridiron for the last time.

Tipton Coach Bernice Moore of Mercer told a Herald reporter, is one of the best guards in the South. 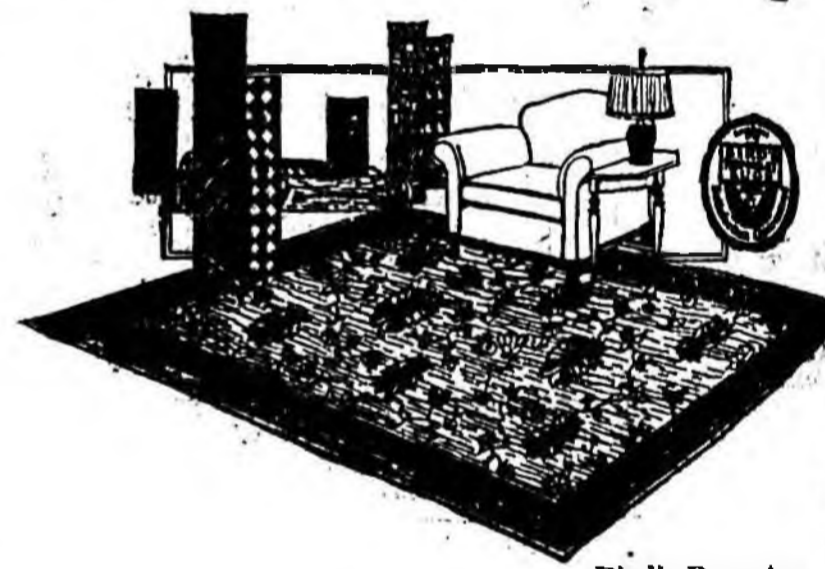

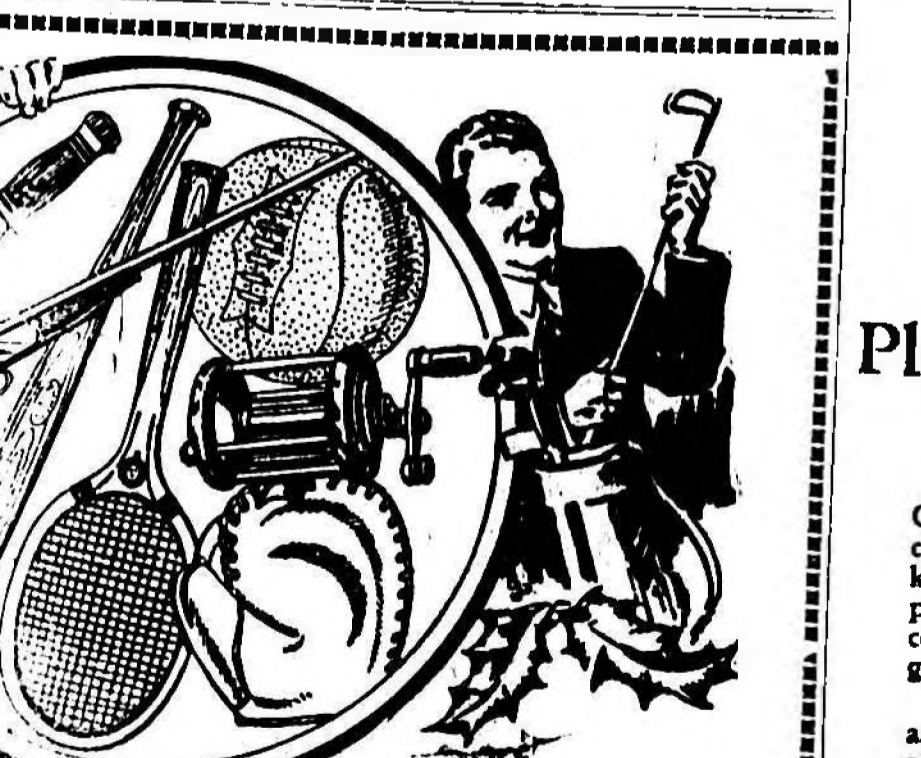
