Influenza Cases On Increase Say Health Officials

Fully 50,000 Persons Now Suffering With Ailment, Is Report

WASHINGTON, Jan. 22. (AP)—A sharp rise in reported influenza cases was announced Thursday night by the U. S. public health service.

"Public health service doctors pointed out that probably the actual cases in the United States numbered close to 50,000 since the three major population states of California, New York and Massachusetts do not report influenza and other states do not have complete data in all cases," the report said.

"Influenza cases are showing an increased percentage of cases with complications such as pneumonia and other respiratory ailments," the report said.
