

Italy's Position

Optimistic foreign observers who have been predictng a complete break in the Rome-Berlin Axis should read with interest Italy's recent warning to Russia to keep out of the Balkans. They may see in this further proof of their contention, if they believe that the Russo-German alliance is a real one, but they are forgetting that it is as much to German interests, as to Italian, to keep Russia out of the Balkans.

It seems to us it is perfectly clear The Germany made the best deal she could with Russia, and not a very good one at that, because she couldn't do anything else. She could not fight a war with Britain and France on one side and with Russia on the other at the same time, as she tried to do with little success in 1914. She had to come to terms with Russia because she could not come to terms with Britain and France, and she no more likes the terms that were made than her Axis partner in Rome.

Now Germany is in no position to tell Russia to leave Rumania alone or to keep out of the Baltic Sea, since for the moment she certainly has her hands full on the Western Front. But there is nothing to prevent her Axis partner who so far has managed to maintain her apparent neutrality in the war in Western Europe, from holding Russia in check if she is strong enough to do it. So Italy is organizing a "peace bloc" in the Balkans and warns Russia to keep out, thus aiding Germany in the east, while Germany is busy in the west.

But don't think that in warning Russia, Italy has any intention of settling her quarrels with the Allies or that she is doing it in the interest of peace and humanity. Italy is just as much the enemy of France and England as she has always been ever since Mussolini came into power, and just as much the friend and supporter of Germany as she has ever been since the origin of the Rome-Berlin Axis.

The cloud of uncertainty which hangs over this relationship is caused by the Russian enigma. When Hitler got together with his long time enemy over the Polish deal, he made an about face which left everyone gasping for breath.
