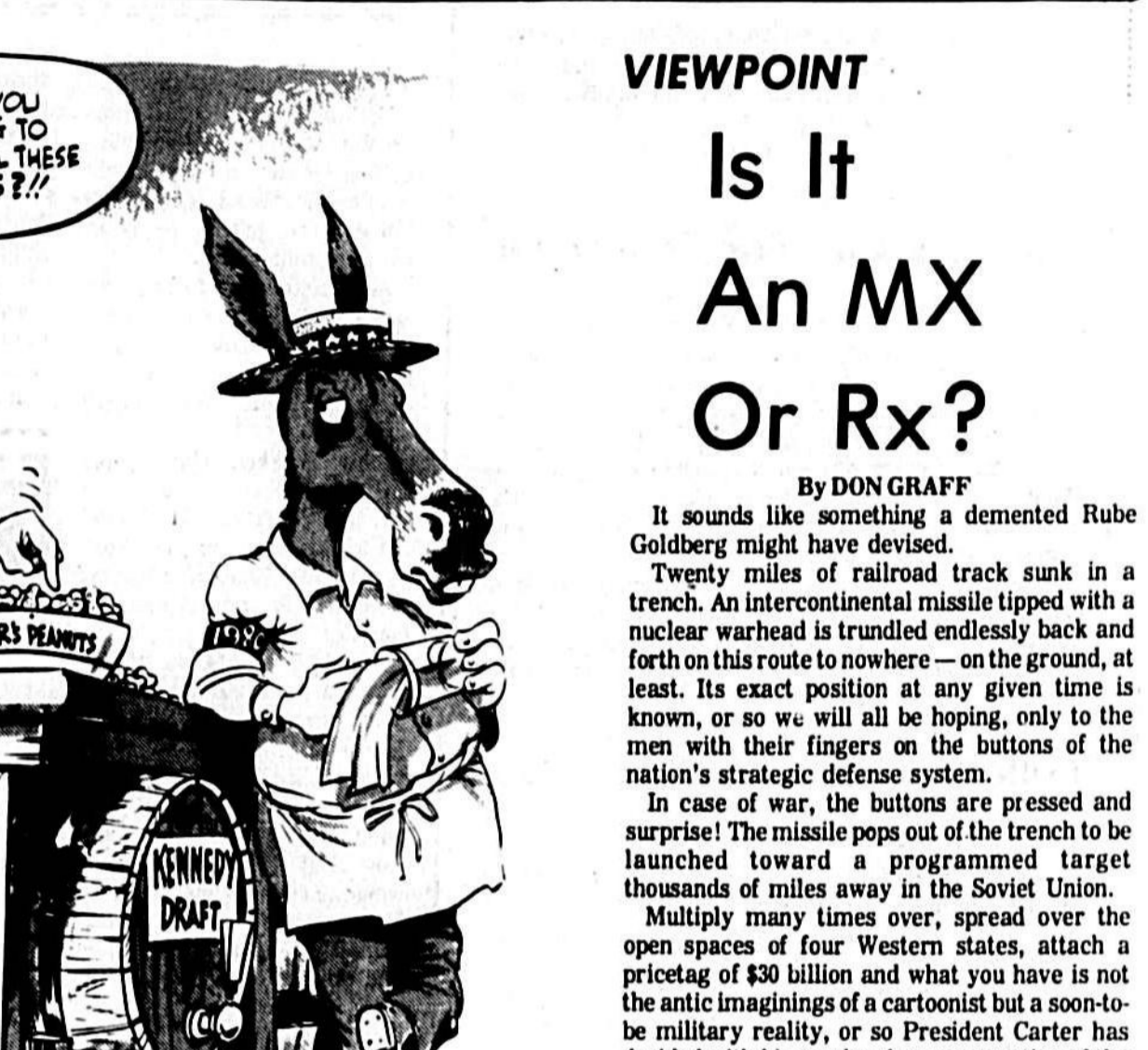

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He Had Eczema Problem Since Birth

DEAR DR. LAMB - My son has had eczema since birth. We have doctors at most of this time and always when he was a baby. The pediatrician said he would outgrow it but he's 31 now.



He clears up sometimes and then breaks out on his body, hands and in his hair. He was given shots for years and still takes them but we really can't see very much help from them.

What is lacking? I had a poor diet before his birth. Isn't there some way one can correct this? I insisted on good foods thereafter. We have three daughters and they have no problems.

When a person inherits this characteristic there are numerous different factors which can precipitate an attack. This might be contact with nothing more than wool clothing.

DEAR READER - The first question is the diagnosis. You need to be sure that it is simple eczema that your son has.

When a person has infections, reddening and other problems, the first goal in treatment is to correct these complications. This may involve taking antibiotics.

Because the problem is related to drying of the skin, it's important to prevent loss of moisture from the skin. One approach to treatment is to avoid taking baths. In severely affected people, doctors often recommend total cessation of baths for long periods of time.

The primary problem in eczema is a dry, itchy skin.

Library Service Eyed For County Outskirts

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State Attorney's Office May Be Moving To Jail

Lawyers and staff members of the state's attorney's office soon may occupy rooms of the criminals they once helped put behind bars.

The county commission Tuesday reviewed a report from the space committee recommending the state's attorney's staff and offices be moved into the jail facility south of the courthouse.

The space committee report recommends that the state's attorney's office utilize the added space in the jail cells as it becomes available through remodeling.

According to the report, the state's attorney's offices now located on the first floor of the courthouse, with added rental space in the Masonic Building, have a total of 3,469 feet of space.

The space committee report recommends a series of shifts that would convert the first floor of the courthouse into a court complex, with an added mini-courtroom and judges' chambers. The juvenile room now on the fourth floor of the courthouse would be moved to either the first or second floor, according to the plan.

One unresolved issue is whether to move the Sanford branch of the County Library. The committee report made no recommendation on the issue, although the report does state that the current library building in
