How Teachers Can 'Stand Tall'

Seminole County teachers currently find themselves in a paradox. On the one hand, they must feel that the Seminoles County officials and the public are strongly in support of their financial problems, because the current Seminoles pay scale is such that their starting salaries are among the highest in the state.

(Last Thursday night all teachers were given a minimum \$250 yearly pay raise.)

On the other hand, the Florida Education Association has indicated they will be asked to "walk out" on the first day of the 1967-68 school year. Their decision will be a tough one to make.

Certainly the FEA has become the strong and dominant organization representing the teachers. Seminole teachers have contributed to its financial as well as its physical strength. Because of this they feel they must be loyal to its principles and to any program it promotes.

But, they also must feel some loyalty to the people of Seminole, who have had an unusual history in supporting education.

These Seminole people have been "having their share" at top property assessment levels in support of a good education for their youngsters.

And their elected officials — the five member school board — have tentatively agreed on this new salary schedule which should meet the requests of the Seminole Education Assn.

The school board took this action in anticipation of legislative and gubernatorial approval of a greatly increased state support for education.

But such increased state support has not been approved.

Therefore the "quantity" of the Seminoles' teachers.
