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Be Careful!

Monday is Labor Day. Between this afternoon and Tuesday morning, millions of Americans, mostly workingmen, will take to the nation's highways for the heat and turmoil of the cities for a day or two's respite among the cool refreshing breezes of mountain or seaside resorts.

The New York Safety Council estimates that of this number more than 400 will be killed and at least 14,000 injured in highway accidents. This does not include drownings and other accidents which will swell the total to among the highest casualties for any similar period of the year.

"Forewarned is to be forearmed." The Labor Day weekend is a dangerous period. Everyone will be in a hurry to get to the beaches. Everyone will stay there until the last minute and then be in a hurry to get home. When such rush periods are on, accidents occur. You can protect yourself and those who are with you by being doubly cautious.

The Safety Council offers five rules: 1.) Heed the traffic signs; obey the signals. 2.) Be alert, take it easy. 3.) Play safe; be considerate, patient. 4.) Stay in line. 5.) Do not speed.

To these might well be added: "Do not drink if you have been drinking." If you feel that you must take a drink, arrange beforehand with someone who is sober to do the driving. Nobody who has been drinking should feel that he is still competent to drive. It is better to be safe than sorry.

In Sanford let's set an example to the rest of the nation in observing an accidentless holiday.

A New Wrinkle

We wonder how many local fishermen are familiar with a new law which prohibits fishing in Florida waters with more than one pole, line, bait, lure bob spinner or reel. We believe it is a rather common practice with certain fishermen to use several lines, and until the Leesburg Commercial editorially explained it we never knew it was against the law.

"The way it came about without our keeping up with it," says the Commercial editor, "was through a subtle amendment for amendment number 1 of the bill. That substitute was offered by Simpson of Jefferson county and it was held in abeyance while other amendments were offered and turned down before it finally came to vote.

"By that time, we believe, the members of the house were as much at sea as we were when they voted for that substitute they did not know which one it was and what it contained. So it went on through. Everybody was busy and nobody checked it carefully and the senate took it as it came, leaving that obnoxious provision in it.

"But somebody did catch another thing in that substitute for the bill that passed the house provided for a license fee of \$1.00 for which the county judge shall receive a fee of 10 cents. That got changed to an extra quarter for the judge. But it still left the original single equipment for a fisherman.

"Many real sportsmen—and they are our real conservationists—carry two rods and reels, one fitted with under-water bait and one with topwater plug. They use one a while and then the other. But when they come in with both lines wet, there is prima facie evidence they have fished with two lines contrary to law.

"There is a howl—and rightly so."

Saving Our Children

Some of the most notable progress made by the medical profession has been in reducing deaths and illness in childhood.

Dr. G. E. Wakerlin, recently described the achievements in this direction that have been made in the representative state of Illinois. The number of deaths of Illinois children under ten is now one-tenth of what it was in 1910. Each of the eight major causes of childhood death—diarrhoea, pneumonia, diphtheria, tuberculosis, scarlet fever, whooping cough, measles and meningitis—has been robbed of much of its destructiveness.

The most important factor in producing this fine result, Dr. Wakerlin points out, "has been the application of knowledge gained by prolonged and painstaking research and experimentation in laboratories, clinics and hospitals."

From Vacuum Cleaner To Gas Mask; Or How Defense Reshapes Industry

WASHINGTON, Aug. 30.—National defense has given new meaning to the word "conversion" and there are few industries with production and pocketbooks squeezed by priorities and the like who aren't lying awake nights thinking about it.

"Conversion" means changing plant facilities from manufacture of articles for civilian consumption to articles for national defense.

The complications of it can be left until another time. What started out to tell you was that "conversion" is making some of the strangest industrial bedfellows that ever stretched out on an assembly line.

It may not be so startling that H. F. Goodrich, the rubber producer, is leading bus-making shells and bombs at a Texarkana, Tenn. plant, or that Willys-Overland Motors, right along with their "Jeeps," are turning out 150-millimeter shells—but the Army contract records do give you a hint when you see that the nation's largest manufacturer of mousetraps now are getting a path beaten to their door to pick up thousands of Army cotas.

You wouldn't expect the Kohler Corp. at Kohler, Wis., which is responsible for a lot of toilet room fixtures, to be making fuses—but once you learn that down, try to figure out why the electrical makers, whose only competitors heretofore have been in the realm of remotes, are making these little gadgets that set off death from the sky.

While we are in the conversion field note too that a big London N. J. producer of composite materials is rolling out pressure-resistant pipe from rubber and glass.

Pipe from rubber and glass—over on Seattle's Stevens-Cooker machine, as if they didn't have enough to do in wartime, are doing three shifts a day on beach chairs and fuses.

Two aluminum airplanes are being made before you can say "aluminum" and they're being made in a way that's setting records.

OSRD is the Office of Production Administration. It's a new agency, set up by the War Relocation Authority, to coordinate the production of war materials.

ORLANDO, Aug. 30.—(Special)—Defense savings stamps will be placed on sale at all Florida chain stores starting Sept. 13, according to an announcement by Chester B. Treadway, managing director of the Florida Chain Store Association.

In addition to selling stamps, the stores will feature the sale of national defense needs in all advertising in newspapers and other mediums.

How long the stamps will be on sale will depend largely upon the response the public gives. Treadway asserted, holding that the store managers were interested only in aiding the defense effort to the best of their ability.
