Rocketing Into Future

"A Method of Reaching Extreme
Altitudes" was how Robert H. Goddard titled a 1919 paper on rockets.
At the recent Fourth Goddard Memorial Symposium, sponsored by the American Astronautical Society, the American Astronautical Society, the rocket pioneer's successors launched a few flights of fancy into the extreme altitudes of the future—specifically, into "Fiscal Year 2001."

"The interplanetary flight corridors from Mercury to Saturn are alive with manned vehicles of relatively luxurious and sophisticated design, driven by quite advanced propulsion systems," said former V-2 scientist Krafft A. Ehricke describing the first year of the 21st century.

By that time, he predicted, unmanned probes will have approached the sun as close as 14 million miles and gone as far out as Pluto, an average of 3.7 billion miles from the earth.
