In Western terms, the reforms Just decreed by KIng Fahd of Saudl Arabla are minimal. yet in the Saudi context they are progressive.
For the frut IIme. a kingdom whose polltical philosophy is rooted in medieval practices derived from the Koran is to have something
like a written constitution, including a bill of like a writen constitution, including a bill of
rights to shield citizens from the exceases of the country's notorious rellglous police. The klng, who relains full powers,
nonetheless will seek regular advice from a nonetheless will seek regular advice from a on-member consultative councll on matiers of councils will have more authorty on budget and development matters, and the process of oyal succession will be braodened to allow prince of the house of Saud.
Even if all that comes to pass. It hardly means that Saudi Arabla is about to become a constliullonal monarchy, much less a fully changes secm motivlated more by a fear of growing discontent. af home and in the Arab world gencrally. whith the royal house's feudal culing style that pluralism.
Even so. The changes are siginicant, In pari
because Saudi Arabla is to the Muslim world as the Vatican is to Roman Catholiciam - the defender of the falth and keeper of the holy normous oll wealth, which gives it a worldly infuence beyond its otherwise modest assets. That innuence has lis limits. Iraq's selzure posed to the Soudl monarchy was greated in much of the Musllm world not by outrage but by checrs. Whatever notion remained that hheckbook diplomacy could forever Inoulate
