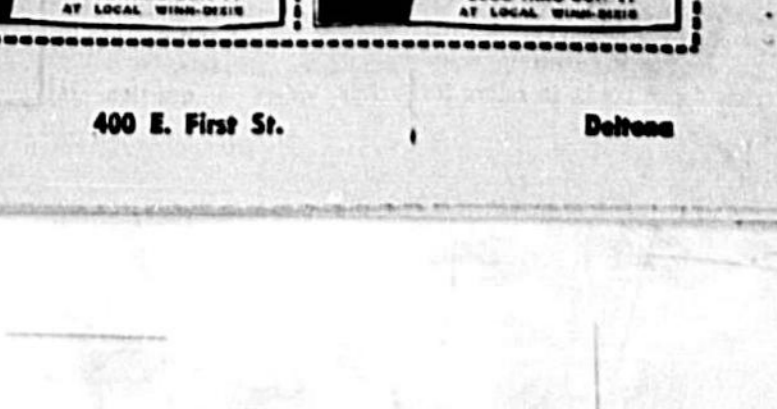
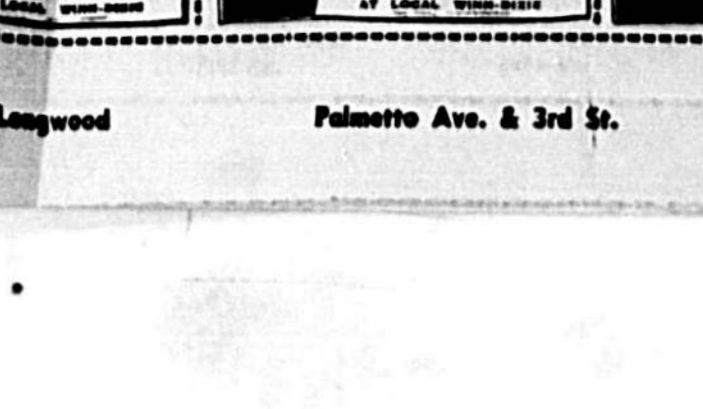
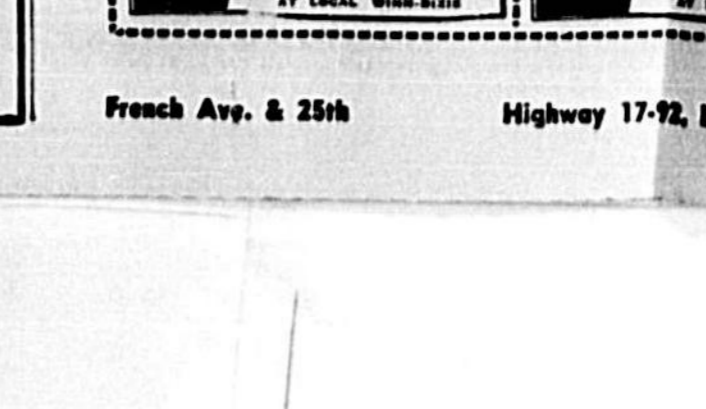
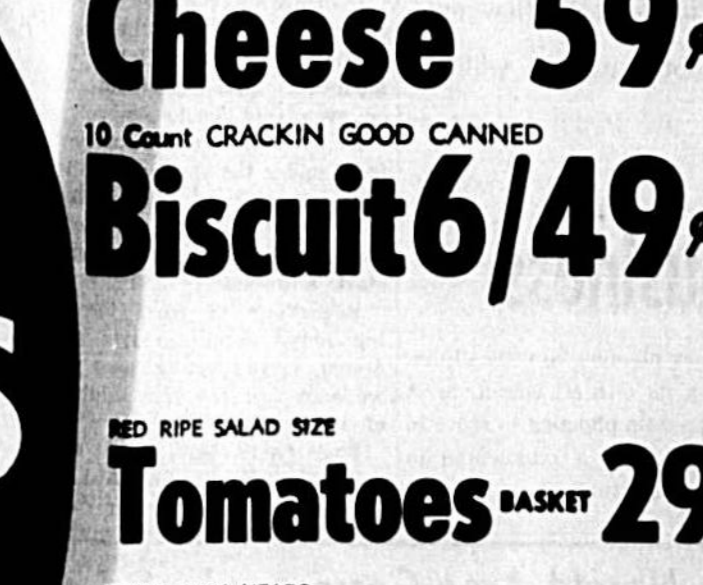
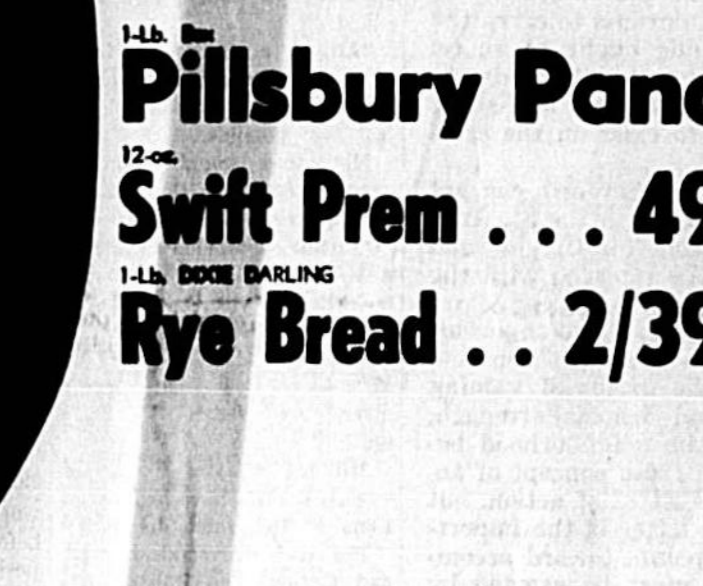
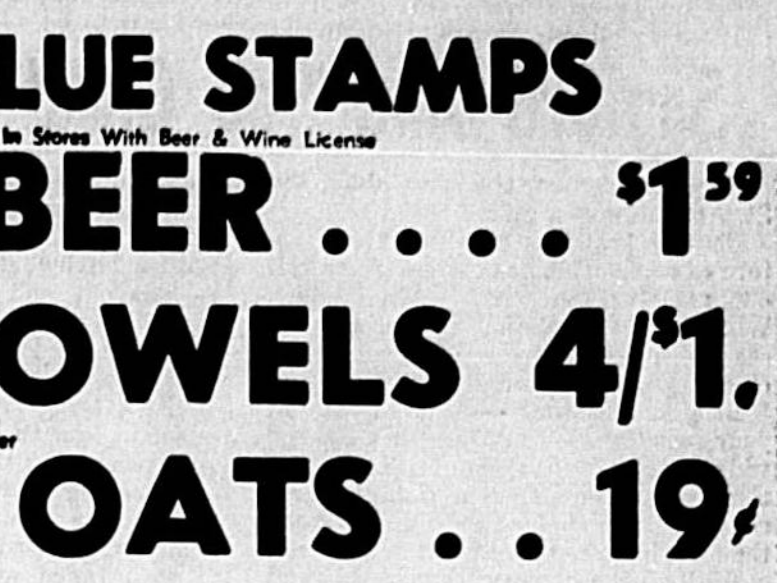
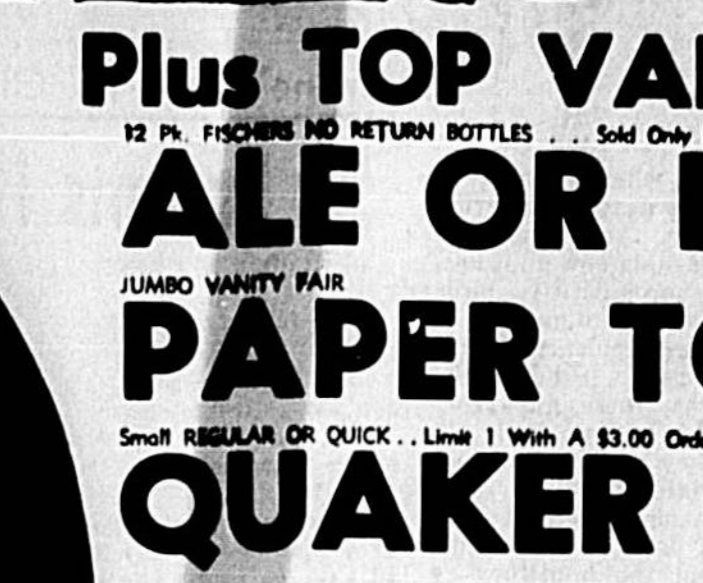
"I think now as I have always thought we have the best hotel rooms and the finest convention hall and I am certain that in 1972 we'll just try a little harder," Demers said.

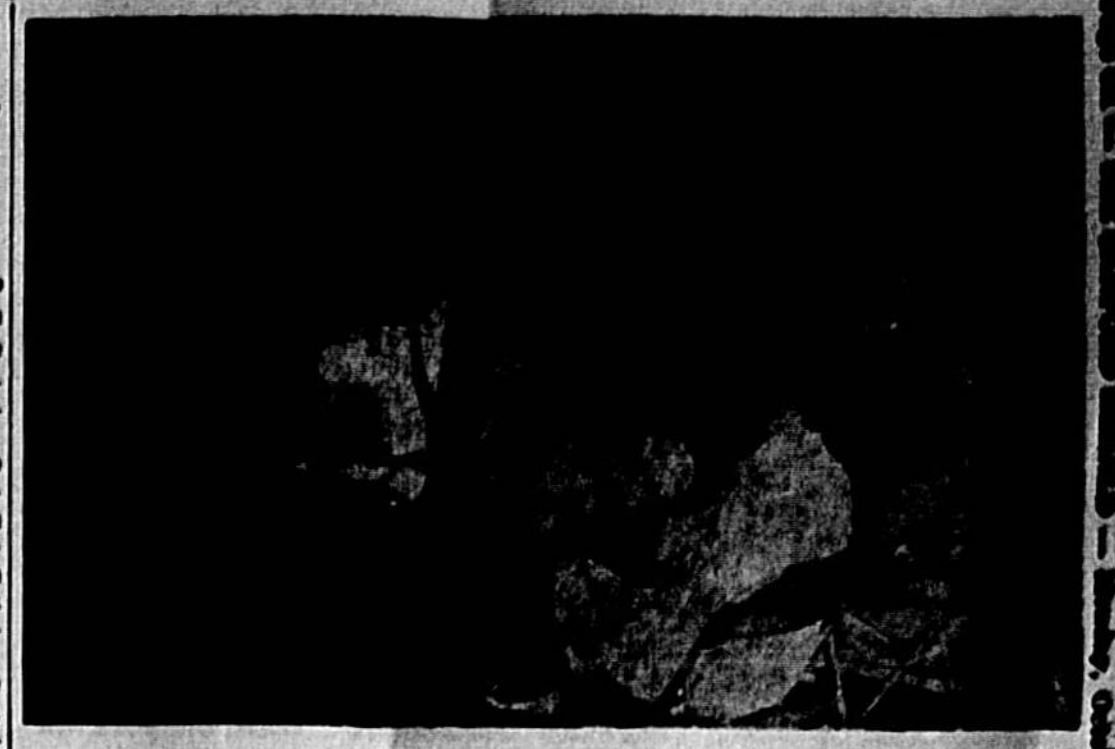

SAIGON (AP) — U.S. Navy fighter-bombers struck a North Vietnamese MIG airfield near Haiphong Sunday, the sixth in a series of strikes in five straight days of raids on targets once ruled by the Pentagon as out of bounds for U.S. airplanes.

The Cat BI strike damaged a Soviet built liaison plane, but the U.S. Command said the carrier-based jets found no MIGs on the ground as they flew in "virtually unopposed."

The raid was part of a maximum U.S. effort to cripple the North before the monsoon rains start this month and cut flying time by as much as 75 per cent. Since Wednesday, U.S. planes have also hit three bridges on supply routes from Red China and two fuel dumps, all previously barred as too sensitive to attack.

The two major MIG bases still on the forbidden list are the Gia An installation and the big Phuoc Yen base, which houses the North Vietnamese air force's major operations center and serves as headquarters for the air defense command. Both are near Hanoi.

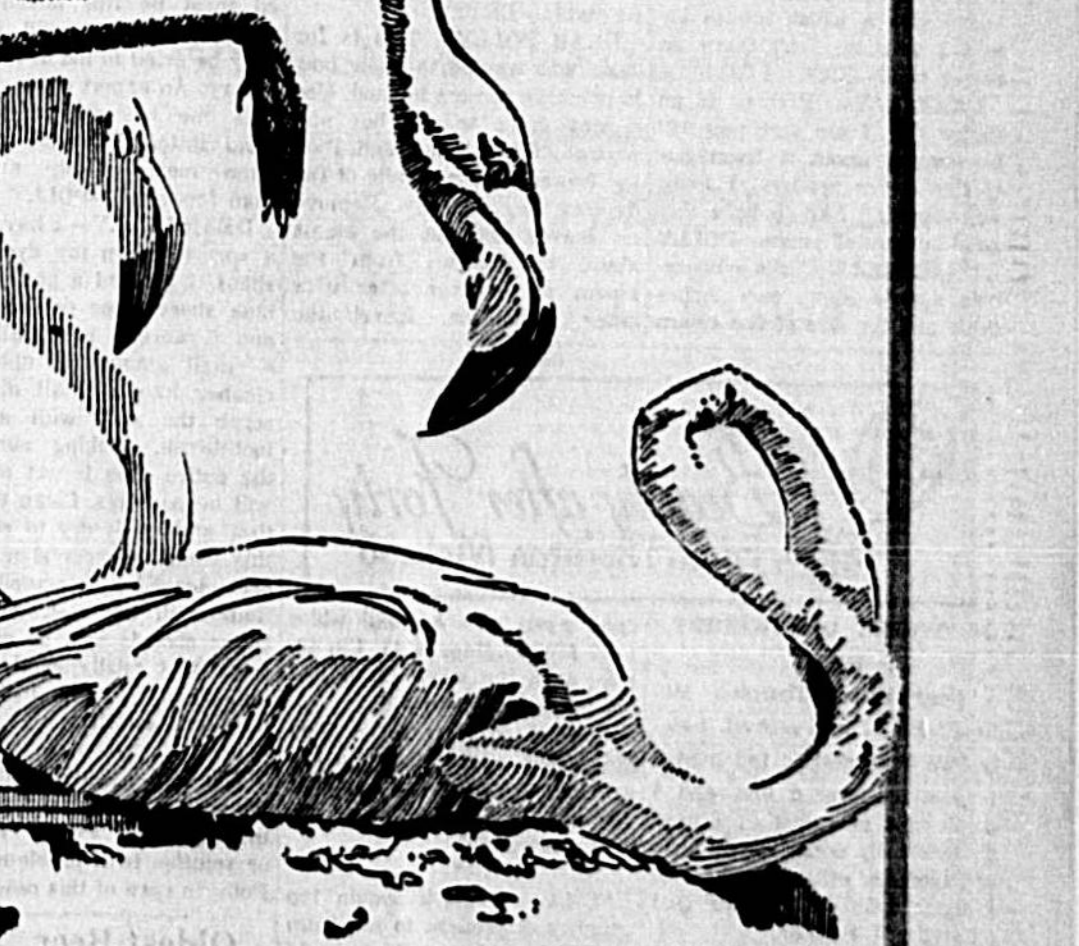
