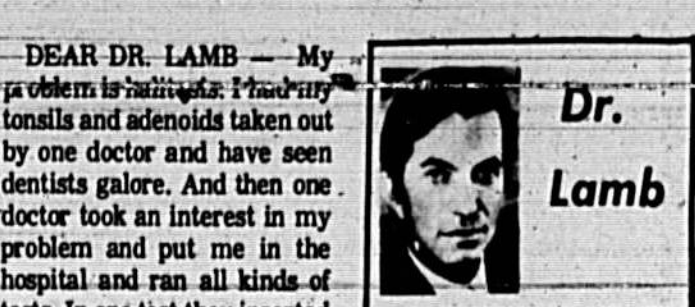

The code is a compilation of all the rules and regulations relating to land development prepared by city staff. Some revisions of those rules were made by a special Land Use Advisory Committee in March.

"If we spend time in a spirit of cooperation, it will save time in the long run," Goetz said. He pointed out that preparing the proper regulations will avoid continual requests for variances.

County Land Development Administrator Herb Hadden said the new code contains a lot of major changes and benefits all around - both to the county and the applicants (builders).

Liberty City: A Grim Lesson

For millions of Americans, the televised scenes of the recent rioting in Miami together with the tragic toll of dead and injured can only have evoked painful memories of the fires that seared so many of this country's cities during the 1960s. Now, as then, we are left to ask why it happened. By all accounts, the immediate provocation was the acquittal of four former Dade County police officers charged with the beating death of an insurance agent apprehended for a traffic violation. The insurance agent was black. The four policemen charged with killing him were white, as were the members of the jury that acquitted them.

But however outrageous these circumstances, and especially the jury's decision, this case alone seems unlikely to have incited the worst rioting in the United States in more than a decade. In fact, the death of the insurance agent and the acquittal of those charged with his murder were but the latest in a series of incidents perceived in Miami's black community as evidence of a racially motivated double standard of justice and law enforcement.

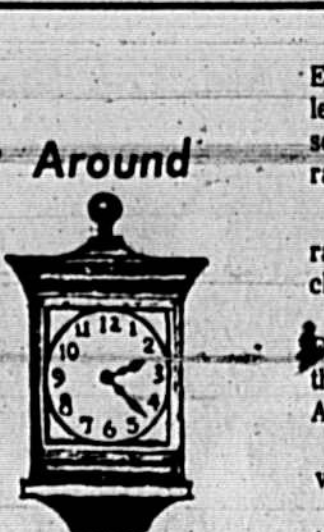
These corrosive suspicions, and the simmering discontent they bred, were surely compounded by the economic distress of much of Miami's black population. Nearly 40 percent of Dade County's 225,000 black residents have incomes that fall below the poverty level. Unemployment in the black community there stands at 17 percent, a full 10 percentage points higher than the national unemployment rate. And, unless Miami's black community has somehow escaped a national phenomenon, unemployment among black youths in Miami probably runs to 40 percent or more.

Thus, it is not terribly difficult to understand how some of those living in Miami's Liberty City ghetto could imagine that the statistical gains registered by black Americans in the aggregate since the early 1960s had no relevance for them. It is a lamentable fact of American political life that voter registration among poor blacks is abysmally low. For whatever complex mix of reasons, all too many ghetto dwellers see no point in the conventional forms of political participation. There can be no doubt, then, that some portion of the motivation for the mayhem in Miami should be attributed to rage on the part of people who saw themselves as dispossessed and, worse yet, powerless.

None of this, of course, can be permitted to justify murder, assault, arson and looting — all integral components of the two nights of rioting in Miami. At least 17 persons are dead and more than 350 injured. The casualties, some shot by snipers and others dragged from their cars and kicked to death, include blacks as well as whites. Property damage, still being tabulated, will run into the hundreds of millions of dollars. Some of the businesses looted and burned upon will not reopen, and this will mean fewer jobs for black citizens who need them desperately. Nor will the rioting do anything, for the moment at least, to improve race relations in a city, like so many others, where racial harmony is a fragile commodity requiring constant care.

Still, there are constructive lessons that can be learned even before the ashes cool in Liberty City. One is that the quest for maximum economic opportunity for all citizens must be pursued lest we condemn an underclass of poor — not all black by any means — to permanent dependence, despair and frustration-spawned violence. And the second is that while this larger challenge is being met, public officials must ensure that law enforcement and administration of justice are color-blind, and that this is perceived by every citizen.

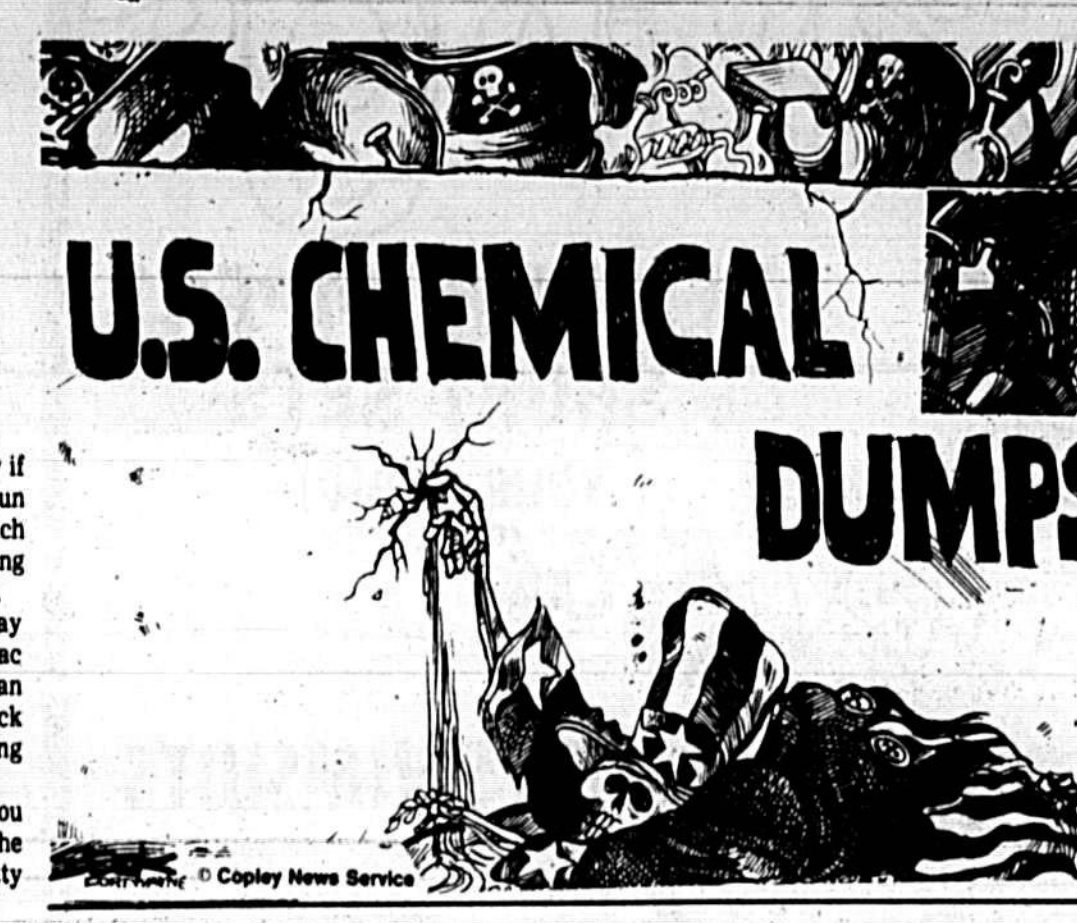
"Chief, I think you should give first consideration to balancing the ticket. Preferably a moderate to offset your extremism."

In the first indictment Tuesday, a New York grand jury charged Rep. Michael Blumenthal, D-Pa., with accepting \$50,000 in bribes from undercover agents.

The indictment also charged Myers shared another \$35,000 with Mayor Angelo Errichetti of Camden, N.J., Philadelphia City Councilman Louis Johnson and Philadelphia lawyer Howard Criden.

The congressman declined direct comment until he had a chance to study the indictment. Myers' Washington lawyer, Flato Cacheris, accused prosecutors of breaking a promise to give him advance warning of the indictment. "He will plead not guilty," Cacheris said. Myers, 36, a second-term congressman, recently won the Democratic nomination to

Terrorist Groups And Nuclear Power

WASHINGTON — While the possibility of a nuclear holocaust is of paramount concern to world leaders, a more likely threat is a deadly terrorist attack on the nuclear power industry. 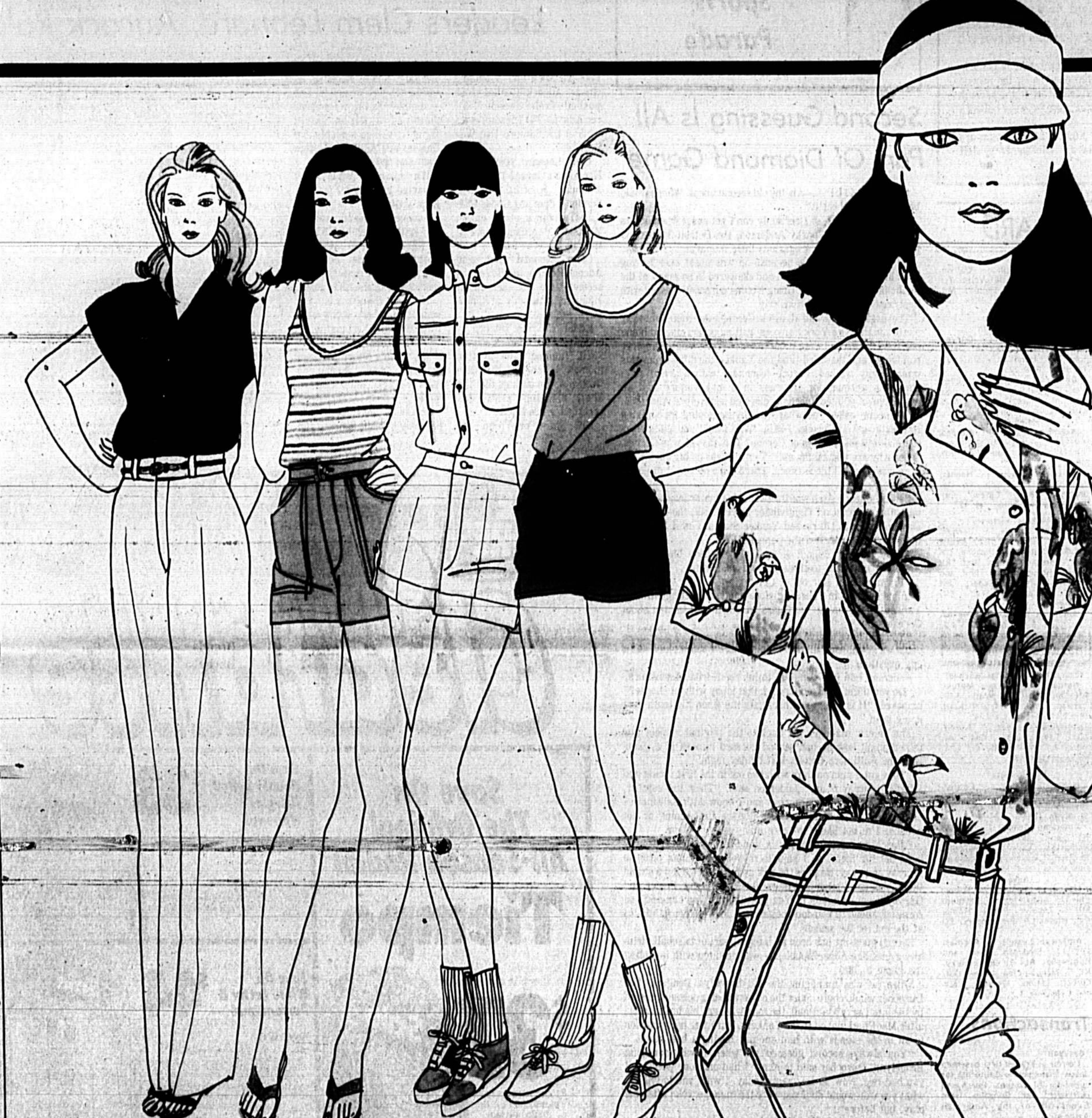

# 'Dallas' Head Says Evening 'Soaps' Could Soon Fade

NEW YORK (UPI) — The president of the production company that has made nighttime soap operas among television's biggest hits thinks they might soon be going out of style.

"These things go in cycles," Lee Rich, who heads Lorimar Productions, said in an interview.

Lorimar are those wonderful people who gave you "Dallas," "Knots Landing," "Eight Is Enough" and "The Waltons." Three of those shows helped put CBS in the top ratings spot for the season just past and "Eight Is Enough" helped ABC

come right up there.

Coming up in the new season that begins next September, Lorimar will have "Secrets of Midland Heights," which sounds like "Peyton Place" in a new, updated setting, and "Flamingo Road," based on the old Joan Crawford film. "Secrets" will be a CBS weapon in the ratings race, while "Flamingo" goes for NBC.

"Yeah, they're soap operas, sort of," Rich conceded. He was pleased with the quality of his new pilots, but he has no special affection for the nighttime drama form that has been so suc-

cessful of late for Lorimar.

"I'm a heavy believer in anything that sells and that makes it not going to be on the air. You can smell it if you've been around. I could have told you in advance what pilots of ours had a chance and what pilots did not — but if the networks are paying for them, we'll do as they ask."

Asked what he thought of the upcoming television season, now that the networks have revealed their tentative schedules, Rich said, "I think it sounds pretty boring. I think CBS is a little better than ABC."

A company such as Lorimar each year finds itself working on two kinds of pilots — those the company has committed up-

In large skillet brown chicken in oil over medium heat about 10 minutes on each side. Remove chicken; set aside. Drain oil but do not remove fat from skillet. Add eggplant and onion to skillet; cook and stir over medium heat 5 minutes. Mix in tomatoes, salt, basil and pepper. Cook and stir 5 minutes; pour into 2-quart casserole. Top with chicken skin-side-up. Bake in 375-degree oven 25 minutes. Increase temperature to 400 degrees. Sprinkle chicken with almonds; continue to bake 15 to 20 minutes until chicken is cooked through and almonds are lightly browned. Makes 4 servings.

**HERB BISCUIT LOAF**  
 1/2 cup margarine or butter, softened  
 1/2 teaspoon instant minced onion  
 1/2 teaspoon sweet basil leaves  
 1/2 teaspoon caraway seed  
 1/2 teaspoon garlic powder  
 2 (10-oz.) cans refrigerated big flaky biscuits  
 Heat oven to 350 degrees F. In small bowl, combine all ingredients except biscuits. Separate dough into 40 biscuits. Spread both sides of each biscuit with margarine mixture, fold each in half. Place biscuits, fold-side-down, in ungreased 9x5 or 8x2-inch loaf pan forming 4 rows of 5 biscuits each. Spread any remaining margarine mixture over biscuits.  
 Bake at 350 degrees F. for 32 to 38 minutes or until deep golden brown. Cool 5 minutes; remove from pan. Serve warm.  
 1 loaf, 10 servings.  
**TIP:** To reheat, wrap in foil; heat at 375-degree F. for 10 minutes or until warm.

**COWPOKE SKILLET**  
 4 slices bacon  
 1/2 c. chopped green pepper  
 1/4 c. chopped onion  
 1/4 tsp. marjoram leaves, crushed  
 2 cans (19 oz. each) chunky beef soup  
 1 can (about 8 oz.) whole kernel golden corn, drained  
 1 Tbsp. cornstarch  
 2 Tbsp. water  
 2 c. prepared mashed potatoes  
 1/2 tsp. grated Parmesan cheese  
 In saucepan, cook bacon until crisp; remove and crumble. Pour off all but 3 Tbsp. drippings. Cook green pepper and onion with marjoram in drippings until tender. Add soup, corn and bacon. Blend cornstarch and water until smooth; add to soup mixture. Cook, stirring until thickened. Meanwhile, combine potatoes and cheese. Top beef mixture with potatoes. Makes about 5 1/2 cups, 4 servings.

**PICNIC CHICKEN**  
 1 packet oven fry coating for chicken, crispy crumb recipe  
 1/4 cup oil or melted shortening  
 1 egg  
 1 tablespoon water  
 2 1/2 pounds chicken pieces  
 Preheat oven to 400 degrees. Empty packet of coating onto a sheet of waxed paper or into a shallow bowl. Spread oil in a 15x10x1-inch jelly roll pan. (A flat-bottom pan with sides not more than 1 inch deep gives best results.) In a large bowl, beat egg with fork; add water and blend. Add all the chicken and toss gently to moisten each piece on all sides. Starting with large pieces, place chicken in coating, one piece at a time. Pile coating on chicken, then press firmly on all sides until the piece is thickly and evenly covered. Place chicken in pan, skin side down. Fry in oven 25 minutes, then turn and fry 25 minutes longer, until chicken is tender. Remove from pan immediately. Makes 4 servings.

**PASTEL FREEZE**  
 1 envelope unsweetened soft drink mix, any flavor  
 1 cup sugar  
 2 cups milk  
 1 envelope Dream Whip whipped topping mix  
 Combine soft drink mix, sugar and milk, stirring until thoroughly mixed and sugar is dissolved. (Soft drink mix will dissolve during freezing.) Pour into shallow nonmetal container or bowl. Freeze until partially frozen, about 1 hour. Prepare whipped topping mix as directed on package. Beat soft drink mixture until smooth, but not melted; fold in prepared whipped topping. Freeze until firm, 3 to 4 hours. Makes 1 quart or 8 servings.

**REMOLADE SAUCE**  
 2 packages (12 oz. each) frozen Alaska Snow crab claws  
 Lettuce  
 1 cup mayonnaise  
 1 tablespoon capers, chopped  
 2 teaspoons Dijon mustard  
 1 teaspoon finely chopped parsley  
 1 teaspoon chopped fresh tarragon or 1/4 teaspoon dried tarragon leaves, crushed  
 2 hard-boiled eggs  
 Place crab, tarragon on lettuce-lined salad plates. To make Remolade Sauce, combine mayonnaise, capers, mustard, and tarragon, blend thoroughly. Place small amount of sauce in cup at one end of plate. Slice egg yolks and egg whites separately. Garnish crab with sieved yolks and whites.

**CURRIED APPLE AND CHICKEN SALAD**  
 3 Cape Grassy Smith Apples  
 2 Tbsp. lemon juice  
 1 Tbsp. salad oil  
 3-4 cups cooked cubed chicken  
 1-2 cups cooked rice  
 1 cup mayonnaise  
 1/4 cup chopped cashew nuts  
 2 Tbsp. chopped parsley  
 1 Tbsp. chopped onion  
 1 tsp. curry powder  
 1 tsp. salt  
 Core and dice apples. Place in large bowl; add lemon juice and oil. Stir in chicken and rice. Mix together mayonnaise, nuts, parsley, onion, curry powder and salt; stir into apple mixture. Chill. Turn into bowl lined with salad greens and garnish with apple wedges. Yield: 8 - 8 servings.

**RASPBERRY MOUSSE**  
 1 1/2-cup package frozen raspberries  
 2 tablespoons gelatin  
 1 teaspoon lemon juice  
 1/2 teaspoon vanilla  
 1/4 tablespoon Kirschwasser  
 1 egg white  
 Pinch salt  
 1/4 cup sugar  
 1 cup cream  
 Thaw raspberries. Combine with gelatin, lemon juice, vanilla, Kirschwasser and salt. Beat egg white until it forms stiff peak. In separate bowl, beat cream and sugar until it peaks. Fold cream mixture, then egg white, into raspberries. Chill. This kitchen-tested recipe makes 4 to 6 servings.

**SALMON SUPREME**  
 1 can (15 1/2 or 18 ounces) pink salmon  
 1 can (10 1/2 ounces) condensed cream of chicken soup  
 1/4 cup sour cream  
 one-third cup minced onion  
 1/4 teaspoon dried dill weed  
 1/4 teaspoon salt  
 1/4 teaspoon pepper  
 3 cups cooked rice  
 1 can (1 1/4 ounces) all-green asparagus cut spears and tips (drained)  
 1 cup grated Cheddar cheese  
 Drain, bone and flake salmon; reserve liquid. Heat soup, salmon liquid, sour cream, onion, seasonings, and rice. Fold in salmon. Turn into a greased, shallow 9-inch baking dish. Arrange asparagus over salmon mixture. Sprinkle with cheese. Bake at 350 degrees for 20 minutes. Makes 6 to 8 servings.

 1/2 orange, sliced  
 1/2 lemon, sliced  
 1/2 cup coconut rum liqueur  
 Mix together zwieback crumbs, nuts, baking powder and salt. In small bowl of electric mixer beat egg yolks with 1 cup sugar, orange rind and vanilla until thick and lemon-colored. In large bowl of electric mixer beat egg whites until stiff. Fold in yolk mixture and dry ingredients. Pour mixture into a greased 9x13-inch baking dish. Bake in a 350 degree F. oven 25 minutes. Meanwhile in small saucepan combine remaining 1/4 cup sugar water; cook over low heat, stirring constantly until sugar is dissolved. Add orange and lemon slices; boil, uncovered, 20 to 25 minutes until liquid is reduced to 1/4 cup; Remove from heat, discard fruit; stir in liqueur. Catch A Ray Of Summer Sunshine





By late summer, these skeletal structures will be part of a 156-unit condominium complex on the 2500 block of Howell Branch Road in south Seminole County. Construction is underway as scheduled on the two and three-bedroom single story units and two-story townhomes. Meanwhile, a site on the north shore of Lake Monroe in the Deltona-Enterprise area is being readied for the start of construction of 550 condominiums.

## Condo Construction Booms In Deltona, South Seminole

Five hundred fifty new condominium units will soon be lining a portion of the north shore of Lake Monroe in the Deltona-Enterprise area. If construction progresses as scheduled, 240 of the units will be ready for occupancy by the first quarter of 1981.

Most of the first 240 units have already been sold, according to Ralph Candeto, director of sales for the builder, the Deltona Corp.

In another area, construction is underway on a 156-unit condominium complex to be located in south Seminole County west of State Road 436 on Howell Branch Road.

Construction will begin for the Deltona-Enterprise development as soon as central sewer installation is completed, Candeto said.

The first phase of the project will be called Lakeside Condominiums and will involve construction of 240 two-bedroom, two-bath units that will have an approximate total selling price of \$18.8 million, Candeto said.

Although the first phase is very nearly sold out, Candeto said units in the next phase or phases are still available.

He explained the Deltona Corp. makes use of worldwide branch offices for selling and the first units were "mostly all sold as soon as they were released."

The complex will be built of masonry (cement block) on the lower level and wood frame on the second level. Each unit will be of the same 932 square-foot floor plan, but location or view and level (first or second story) will determine the purchase price between \$43,450 and \$47,200, he said.

The units will all be centrally heated and cooled and have a balcony or terrace.

The first phase will be built in 20 three-building clusters. Each building will contain four units, two lower level and two upper level. Each cluster will contain 12 units. The complex will have a swimming pool, all-weather tennis courts and one and a half parking spaces per unit.

Candeto said he did not know if the complex would be part of Deltona or the town of Enterprise. It will be located, he said, off Enterprise Road near Doyle Road.

Total estimated cost of the project is \$24 million.

The south Seminole project, known as Eastwood Village, will be located in the 2500 block of Howell Branch Road.

The project will contain single story units and two-level townhomes of stucco and cedar. No unit will be above or below another. The units will have from 1182 to 1634 liveable square feet and will be priced between \$46,900 and \$63,000. The two and three bedroom units will have a minimum of two bathrooms. Models will be available in the late summer, according to sales representative Debra Sochacki.

Ms. Sochacki said each unit will include a number of energy saving devices such as a high efficiency heating and cooling system, R-22 insulation, a unit to utilize hot water from the air cooling system in the heating system, and an energy saving dishwasher.

Unit options, she said, include fireplaces, appliances, screened porches and a cedar vaulted ceiling.

Each purchaser, she added, will have the opportunity to customize his unit with choices of cabinets, carpeting, light fixtures and tile.

"The complex will have a clubhouse, pool and tennis courts, she said and is "quite unique for the area" because the builder has been environmentally conscious in attempts to preserve the natural surroundings.

In addition, she said, the units will be protected by a 10-year National Home Owners Warranty. They will have a Winter Park address. The builder is Harkins Construction of Lake Mary.

## Condition Critical Jordan Shot In Indiana

FORT WAYNE, Ind. (UPI) — Civil rights leader Vernon Jordan was shot in the back and seriously wounded early today in a motel parking lot. Police said they had no suspect or motive for the attack.

Jordan, 44, director of the National Urban League, underwent 4 1/2 hours of surgery at Parkview Memorial Hospital and was listed in critical condition. Doctors said he was struck in the middle of the back by at least one bullet, which apparently fragmented on impact.

The shooting, which occurred at 2:05 a.m. EST, was the first attack on a prominent civil rights leader since the assassination of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. April 4, 1968 in Memphis, Tenn.

Robert Williams, executive director of the Fort Wayne Urban League, said he was convinced the shooting was not racially motivated and had nothing to do with speech Jordan made criticizing a swing to the right in U.S. politics.

Dr. Jeff Towles said Jordan was taken from surgery about 9 a.m. and said he was optimistic about the civil rights leader's condition.

He said Jordan was technically listed in critical condition because of the nature of the wound, but he was in satisfactory condition considering the amount of time he was in surgery.

Towles said he and Dr. Charles Schoenals found the main injury was internal bleeding and there was no fear of spinal injury.

The doctors could not determine how many times Jordan was shot because bullet or bullets fragmented. Towles said Jordan was shot in the back between the chest and pelvis.

Jordan spoke to about 450 people at an Urban League dinner Wednesday night at the Marriott Inn in Fort Wayne, attended a reception afterward, then left the motel and returned about 2 hours later.

Police spokesman Dan Gibson said a woman accompanying Jordan told investigators he parked his car about 50 feet from his room, got out and walked toward the rear of the auto.

Police said Martha Coleman, 36, a local Urban League director escorting Jordan back to his hotel, told investigators she heard a shot and Jordan fell to the ground.

Motel spokesman John Mann said Mrs. Coleman went to the front desk of the hotel and asked for an ambulance. He said motel security officer Bill Smith rushed out to Jordan.

"I understand he (Jordan) did point in the direction he felt the bullet came from," Mann said. "He said he was going to pass out, but he was conscious when they got to him, I'm told."

In Washington, FBI director William H. Webster ordered his special agent in Indiana to Ft. Wayne to investigate the shooting.

"If there is any indication of a violation of federal (civil rights) laws, we will devote whatever resources are necessary to bring this investigation to a successful and just conclusion," Webster said.

Jordan was shot in a city that has had relative racial calm for several years. There was a Ku Klux Klan march last fall, but it was orderly.

In the summers of both 1976 and 1977 there were outbreaks in the inner city, with mass gatherings and rock-throwing, but there was no rioting or burning. The disturbances petered out after about a week.

In his speech Wednesday night, Jordan criticized the "blind enthusiasm of the country's apparent move to the right." He urged all blacks to vote in the 1980 presidential election, saying their vote could be decisive.

## Jordan Shooting Stuns National Black Leaders

National black leaders expressed shock today at the shooting of Vernon Jordan, director of the National Urban League, and were at a loss to explain why the highly respected civil rights leader was gunned down.

Dr. Joseph Lowery of Atlanta, president of the Southern Christian Leadership Conference, said, "I'm stunned by it and I'm praying for his recovery. It's a crazy, violent world. But without knowing any further details, I'm just at a loss to understand why or what happened."

Lowery heads the organization founded by Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., who was assassinated in Memphis, Tenn. on April 4, 1968.

Jordan, 44, was shot twice in the abdomen outside a motel parking lot early today in Fort Wayne, Ind. Police said they had no motive or suspects in the shooting.

The Rev. Jesse Jackson of Chicago, president of Operation PUSH, said he was shocked by the shooting and, "I just don't know what it means."

Jackson said he would go to Fort Wayne today to join members of Jordan's family who were flying there.

Jordan's mother, Mary, who owns an Atlanta catering service, said she learned of the shooting about 6 a.m. and was too upset to talk. She said she would fly to Fort Wayne.

Lyndon Wade, executive director of the Atlanta Urban League chapter, said the shooting "was a tremendous shock and something that nobody gets prepared for. We still don't understand why it happened or what the motive was."

Atlanta civil rights activist John Lewis, who worked with Jordan in 1969, called the shooting "a tragedy for someone who has served the blacks and whites of this country as well as Vernon has and ends up hurt in this way. I just hope he can recover and continue to serve in the valuable way that he has in the past."

Dr. Ralph Abernathy, who succeeded King as head of the SCLC, called Jordan "one of the most articulate voices in the civil and human rights movement. He has the ability to cross racial barriers and work with blacks and whites and the Urban League is that type of organization."

## Legislature Clears Liquor License Bill

A bill limiting the number of liquor licenses to be available in Seminole County after the ocean is generated has passed both Houses of the Florida Legislature and is on the way to Gov. Bob Graham for signature. Sen. John Vogt, D-Cocoa Beach, reported today.

Vogt said the bill calls for one license to be issued for each 4,000 residents of the county. The old law permitted one license for each 2,500 residents.

The legislation does not affect motels, hotels, restaurants and private clubs.

Vogt sponsored the measure in the Senate while State Rep. Robert Hal-taway, D-Altamonte Springs, sponsored it in the House.

The legislation was requested by the Seminole League of Civic Associations. Representatives of the league said with the county's population having nearly doubled during the past decade it was expected under the old formula many new licenses would have been granted.

Larry Cole, one of the representatives, said many new licenses might encourage the establishment of bars with adult entertainment.

## Boy Who Lived In Bubble Dies

WASHINGTON (UPI) — Teddy DeVita, forced to live in a sterile environment inside a glass cubicle to protect him from germs his body could not fight, has died from complications caused by frequent blood transfusions.

The 17-year-old, who made medical history by surviving longer than any patient with aplastic anemia — a disease that cripples the body's germ defense system — died Tuesday at the National Institutes of Health in nearby Bethesda, Md.

DeVita developed the ailment in 1972 at the age of 9 and since then had lived behind glass barriers to protect him from germs.

The youngster lived in one of eight sterile isolation rooms set up by the institute for patients prone to infections, although he was sometimes permitted to make short excursions from the hospital, wearing a special space suit.

## Lake Mary To Ponder Project

The Lake Mary City Council and the city's Planning and Zoning Commission will meet in joint session at 6 p.m. today to consider the future of the proposed development by Sanford and Duluth, Minn. industrialist Jeno Paulucci of a 33-acre apartment and commercial section in the city.

The problem facing the planning and zoning commission is whether the city council wants it to adhere to the city's proposed land development plan or to the one currently in force.

City Manager Phil Kulbes said the meeting was called at the request of the Planning and Zoning Commission "primarily to establish what policies the council wants planning and zoning to follow in adhering to the new comprehensive plan."

Paulucci is requesting permission to build apartments, townhouses and a small commercial section at the corner of Rantoul Lane and State Road 46A, Kulbes said.

Planning and zoning has tabled consideration of the proposal until after tonight's meeting. Kulbes said under the existing land use plan the parcel is designated for commercial and multi-family use but on the proposed plan, the parcel is designated for agricultural use.

The city council has not yet adopted the new comprehensive plan. The plan has been sent to Seminole County officials and officials in nearby cities for comment.
