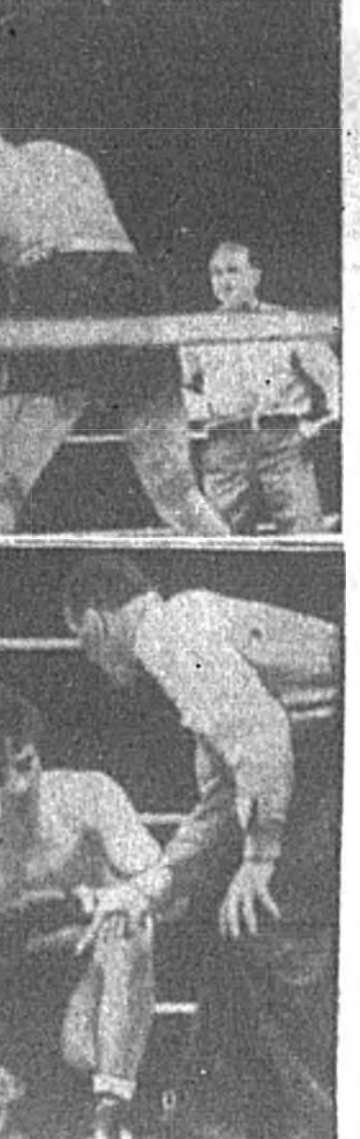

National Socialist Government Is Seen For U. S.

Schlechter's Attorney Sees Nation Under Slow Recovery

WASHINGTON, Sept. 26.—(AP)—Transformation of the United States into a "National Socialist" form of government was visualized recently by Fredrick H. Wood, New York attorney of the Schlechter "sick-chicken" fame, as he opened the first court attack on the constitutionality of the Gaffey coal bill.

Appearing for the Carter Coal Company, West Virginia subsidiary of the Rockefeller-owned Consolidation Coal Company, Wood declared the bill would establish a "little NRA."

Such an agency would be unconstitutional, he contended, because of the Supreme Court decision setting aside the National Recovery Act as invalid. Wood represented the Debevoise brothers of New York before the high court in that important case.

Skirmishing to test the constitutionality of the Gaffey bill opened when John Dickinson, assistant attorney general in charge of anti-trust cases, announced unanswered charges of the coal operators.

The government won the skirmish in the suit but the Gaffey bill remains constitutional.

Justice Daniel W. Brainerd denied the request for a temporary injunction. The case will be heard on its merits later.

Hurricane Hits East Of Cuba; Wind Increases

East Of Jamaica Also Feels Blow Wind Storms Ordered Up

JACKSONVILLE, Sept. 27. (AP)—The southern coast of Cuba this afternoon began to feel strong winds on the outer fringes of the tropical storm which is currently in the Caribbean. A Pan-American plane flying near Santa Cruz, Cuba, reported a northwesterly wind, the southern coast of Cuba was to take precautions against the approach of a fair hurricane. E. Dunn, meteorologist at Weather Bureau here, said traces of the hurricane were strong winds along the Cuban coast from Guantanamo Bay to Cienfuegos. A steamer at 9:00 a.m. clock reported full hurricane winds at 15 miles south of about 15 miles east of the extreme western tip of Jamaica. Kingston, Jamaica had 25.7 barometer and a southeast wind. North of the southeastern coast of Cuba had the same kind of wind reading, and a steamer at present reports "the present storm," it was said by the Weather Bureau. The hurricane was expected to bring Florida a touch of winter weather. At 11:30 A. M. the position of the storm was given as 220 miles northeast of Cuba, Nicaragua. The movement was said by the Weather Bureau to be a continuation of a gradual change in the last two hours. The storm, indicated, moved more than 100 miles north. The Cuba observatory at Havana reported storm winds up to 50 mph in the south and east provinces of Matanzas and Santa Clara. There is an immediate danger in Havana, the observatory said.
