



## **British Army** Plunges On 'Into Burma

New Guinea Allies Battle To Widen Wedge Into Jap Defense System

WASHINGTON, Dec. 22, (AP)—American planes heavily bombed Japan's submarine base at Kiska Island, in the Aleutians Sunday, the Navy reported today, while in the South Pacific Army flying fortresses executed new raids on the enemy airfield at Munda and damaged at least one cargo ahip near Bourainville cargo ship near Bougainville island. The cargo vessel was settling near its stern when

In the far Pacific theater, Gen. Wavell's army from India has driven a total of more than 50 miles into Japaneseoccupied Burma and captured the town of Alethang-Yow, only 45 miles from the big Japanese base at Akyab on the Bay of Bengal.

In New Guinea the Allies were battling to widen their wedge were battling to widen their wedge into the Japanese defense system and wipe out the enemy traped in a pocket in the Buna area.

The Allied attack against the two remaining Japanese strong positions in the Buna area of New Guinea is making steady headway despite the snemy's do-or-die resistance, General MacArthur's communique said earlier today.
