Residents Eye Riches 'Kids' Told: Stop War!

The late father of a ten-year-old boy who fell victim to the "war" between Seminole High School Juniors and seniors today is preparing to sign an official police complaint over the incident, according to Sheriff Chief Arnold Williams.

His son and a companion were abducted by a gang of students Tuesday night, reportedly up to 30 boys-taken to the woods and stripped of their clothing and left to get home as best they could, although completely nude.

Sanford police have been supplied with a list of names of boys reportedly in the gang of abductors. The boys are "labeled" by police officials, pending further action if the official complaint is signed.

The annual spring rites of "hazing" is usually carried on between the Junior and senior classes. However, the two "victims" of Tuesday night's "hazing" were Juniors and seniors. In addition, some of the school's best athletes were attacked reportedly doing either dropouts or past graduates.

Sanford Naval Air Station will not be closed until sometime in 1968, it was revealed today by Donald F. Bradford, director of economic adjustment, Department of Defense.

Bradford said the closing date originally named as July 1, 1967 was "erroneous" and would be at least one to 10 months later than that before the Navy base would be closed here and moved to Turner Air Force Base, Albany, Ga.

This information came out at a press conference held at NAS by Bradford and an inspection team from the Department of Defense.

The group arrived in Sanford Wednesday to work with local leaders in mapping plans for economic readjustment when the base is closed as ordered by the Department of Defense.

"This was mostly a get acquainted tour," Bradford said. "This is the first of a series of frequent meetings which will be held in connection with the closing of the base."

Bradford said he was impressed by local plans for colleges, marina and port development and indicated some of these projects may be utilized in connection with the base.

"I do not believe Sanford will become an economically depressed area when the base is closed," Bradford declared. "San. Mack N. Cleveland Jr."

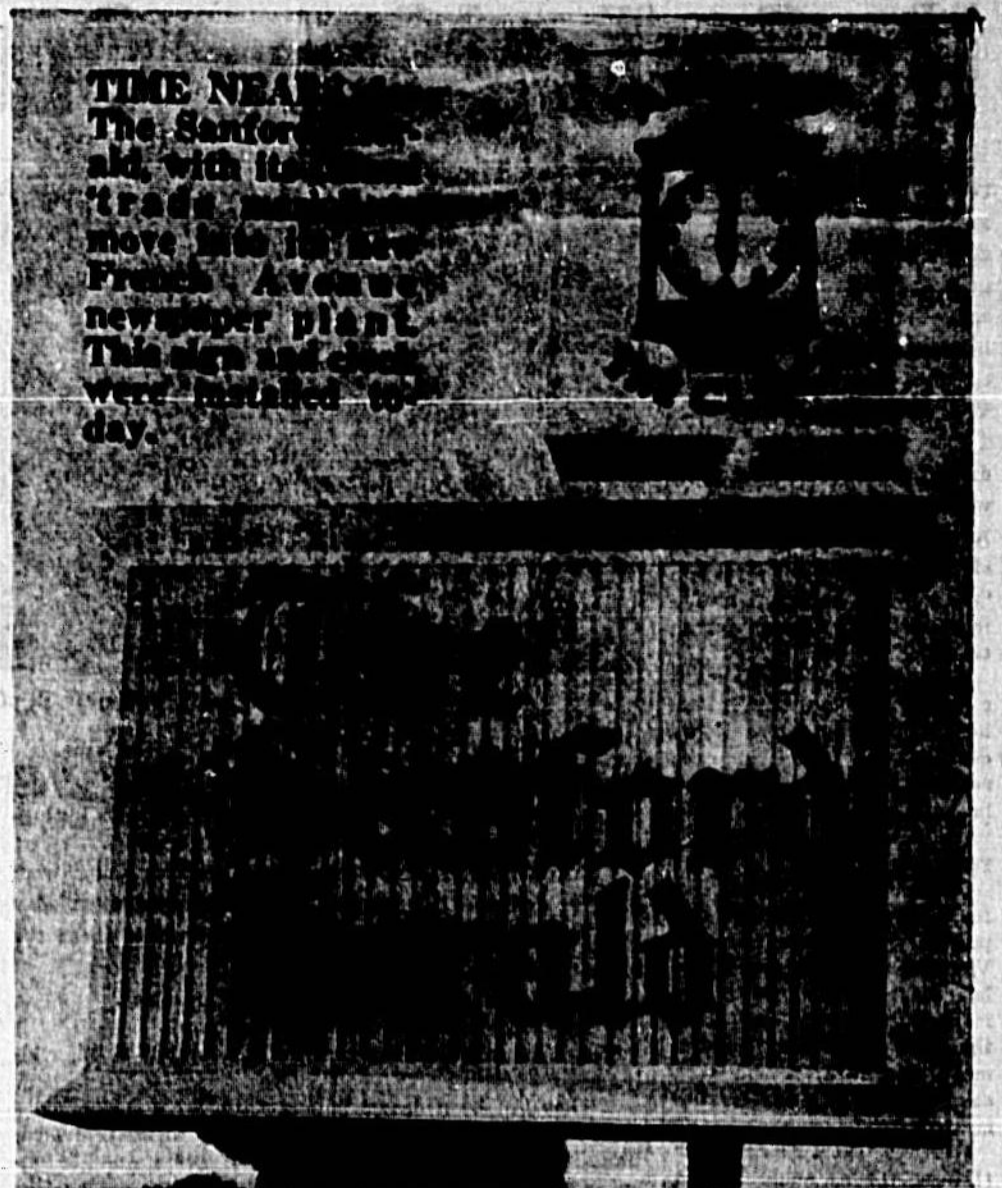
AUXERRE, France (UPI) - Jail officials got a nasty surprise when they stepped last week.
