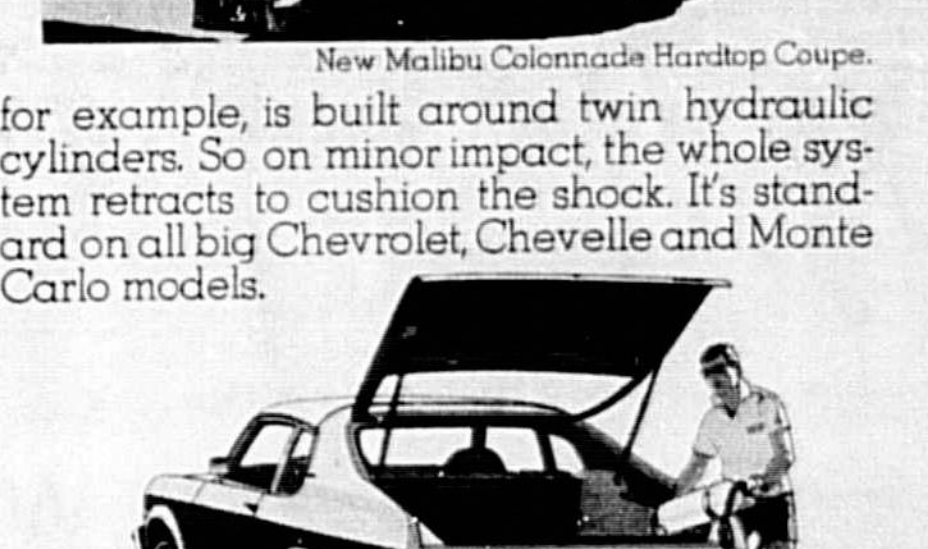

Probes Promised In Wheat Sales To Russians

WASHINGTON (AP) — Two full-scale investigations—one before the election, one after—have been promised in the escalating dispute over wheat sales to the Soviet Union.

The pre-election probe by the FBI was announced by Vice President Spiro T. Agnew while campaigning Tuesday in Minneapolis. In fact, he said, "that investigation is in progress" at President Nixon's orders.

subcommittee investigation of the wheat deal and broader investigations next February "after the passage of the election," he said.

At a Minneapolis news conference, Agnew said that Nixon ordered the FBI probe to answer such questions as whether major grain exporters received and benefited from advance sales information illegally fed to them by USDA officials and former officials.

He accused Democrats of spreading innuendos about the deal. The Iowa congressman said he will press for a full airing of the wheat deal in February or March by a House Small Business subcommittee which he heads.

The deal, he said, raises broader questions about how farmers fare, as compared with exporters, in foreign agriculture trade.

Another House subcommittee, headed by Rep. Graham Purcell, D-Tex., Tuesday completed a three-day probe into allegations that the Agriculture Department engaged in what Democratic presidential candidate George McGovern has called a "conspiracy of silence" by not disclosing full details of Soviet wheat purchases this summer.

Garlic Used For Medicinal Purposes In Olden Days

For centuries, the versatile bulb known as garlic perhaps has been used to flavor more types of food than any other seasoning.

Despite the potent aroma this member of the onion family gives off — by scientific estimate one millionth of an ounce can be detected by the human nostril — garlic is delicate if prepared properly.

In the Mediterranean area where garlic is used lavishly, cooks have discovered that crushing the bulb reduces its potency. Boiling garlic also tames the scent. In fact, kitchen men in Provencal feature a soup composed of a couple of dozen garlic cloves, water and not much else.

In ancient times, garlic served as a food rather than a seasoning. Historians tell us the Egyptian slaves who built the Great Pyramid in the 5th century B.C., virtually lived on garlic and onions. And the Roman poet, Virgil, urged reapers to eat garlic to help them withstand the broiling sun as they toiled in the fields.

Garlic also was used for medicinal purposes in olden days. When one suffered from a toothache, a sliver of the bulb was placed in the cavity. It generally was believed in medieval times that garlic could cure dog bites, poison arrow wounds and the sting of a venomous snake.

One tends to link Italian food with the flavor of garlic and olive oil, and in Piedmont restaurants feature a powerful sauce known as *bagna cauda*, or hot bath. Made from butter, anchovies, white truffles and garlic with olive oil, this authoritative mixture is used as a hot dip for cold raw vegetables and makes a delicious antipasto.

In Milan, they have several garlic specialties that have found their way to America. One is *Osso Buco*, which consists of veal shanks braised with vegetables, white wine and tomatoes. Before being served, this pungent dish is garnished with a mixture of chopped raw garlic, lemon peel and parsley.

One of the most delightful garlic dishes for which Milan is noted is *Vitello Tonnato*. It consists of sliced veal flavored with garlic, wine and herbs, served cold with a sprightly tomato, anchovy and garlic sauce.

Vitello Tonnato is a specialty of L'Aiglon, a restaurant in midtown New York. The owners picked up the recipe in a small trattoria in the Milan region, and adapted it for their cuisine.

blender, two medium cans white-meat tuna, 4 anchovies, 2 teaspoons Dijon mustard, 1 teaspoon garlic powder, 1 teaspoon salt, white pepper. Add 1/2 cup olive oil. Pour sauce over meat, cover and keep in refrigerator 2 days. Serves four as a main course. Good with a chilled Soave white wine.

Separate chicken into individual pieces. If possible, use on home dining tables. But families sometimes get tired of eating the same old way. When this happens at your house, you might like to try this recipe; it is adapted from Mexican cuisine.

CHICKEN WITH ORANGES
1/2 cup flour
1 teaspoon salt
1/4 teaspoon pepper
2 tablespoons salad oil
1/2 small onion, finely chopped
2/3 cup chicken broth (from a 10 1/2-ounce can, undrained)
1/2 cup orange juice
1/4 cup raisins
1 teaspoon aromatic bitters
1/2 teaspoon cornstarch
2 tablespoons cold water
Orange slices

Wash and dry chicken. Mix together flour, salt and pepper; coat chicken with mixture. In a large skillet heat oil; add chicken and brown on both sides. Place chicken in one layer in a shallow baking pan. To drippings in skillet add the onion, chicken broth, orange juice, raisins and aromatic bitters; with a wooden spoon stir over low heat to get up drippings. Pour over chicken. Bake in a preheated 350-degree oven until chicken is tender about 1 hour. Remove chicken and raisins to a platter and keep warm. Pour drippings from baking pan into a cup; let stand until fat rises to top; skim off fat. Pour skimmed drippings into a small saucepan; mix cornstarch with water until smooth; add to saucepan. Cook over moderate heat, stirring constantly until sauce thickens; spoon sauce over chicken. Garnish with orange slices. Serve with yellow rice. Makes 4 servings.

Skillet-cook patties in a small amount of butter over moderate heat for about 3 minutes on each side. Sandwich cooked patties and sliced tomatoes in the hamburger buns. Garnish with pickle slices. Makes 8 servings.

Fringe Benefits 30.8% Of Payroll

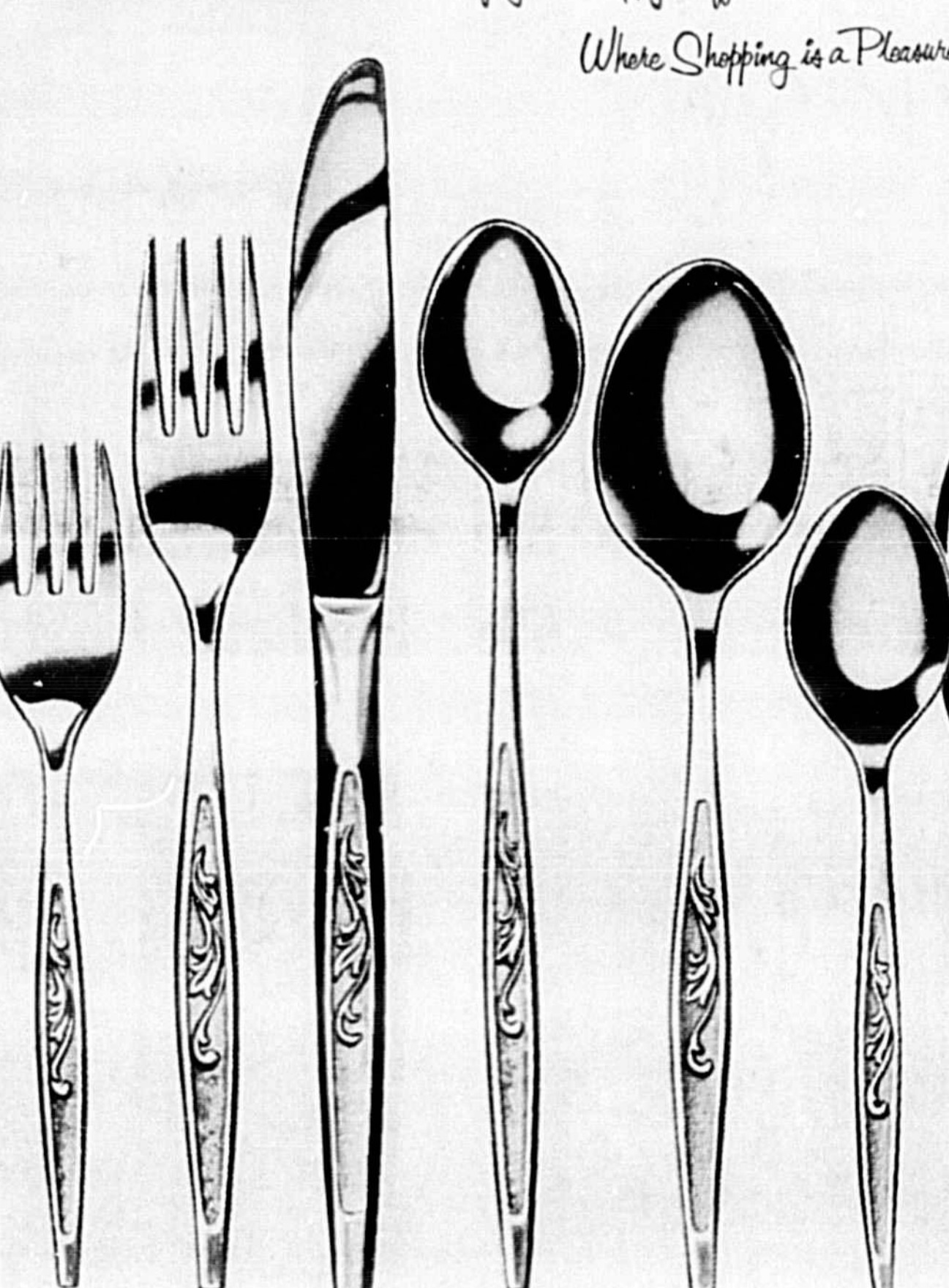

NEW YORK (AP) — If you fail to analyze critically those surveys made from time to time about the swift growth in fringe benefits paid to workers you might believe that life was becoming a big handout. Last year, according to a National Chamber of Commerce study, such benefits accounted for 30.8 per cent of the average firm's payroll. In 1961, the study states, the average annual benefits paid cost \$1,254. Similar payments last year averaged \$2,544, a gain of 103 per cent in one decade. Out of average annual earnings of \$8,200 paid in 1971, the Chamber lists three average benefits per employee: Social Security \$374, up 178 per cent in a decade; insurance \$369, up 171 per cent; paid sick leave \$81, 131 per cent up. Following in order are: profit sharing \$86, up 105 per cent; paid holidays \$244, up 54 per cent; private pensions \$402, up 91 per cent; paid vacations \$400, up 90 per cent; and "other" \$228, up 20 per cent. Does this mean that labor is draining away the vitality of its employer? Some businessmen are inclined toward that point of view. Before jumping to conclusions you must define "worker," because some of the most beneficial fringes are those that make the executive's life more comfortable and financially rewarding. Benefits are not solely a blue-collar phenomenon. Nevertheless, some executives draw on a vast array of statistics showing that corporate profits have indeed been pinched in recent years by rising payroll costs, despite the growth in overall prosperity. But in a broader perspective that includes social good and national goals it is more difficult to assess the impact. Productivity of American factories has not risen as fast as in many countries, but that may be changing. In fact, a study just released by Standard & Poor's shows that "for the first time in recent years there was a significant dip in 1971 in the portion of the sales dollars of industrial companies that went into payrolls." S&P defines payrolls to include wages, salaries and fringe benefits, which it said amounted to only 28 cents for every dollar of sales, down from nearly 28 cents in 1970. The percentage was the lowest since the 1950s. Of 29 industrial groups for which comparisons were made, 19 showed declines in wage-out ratios and 10 reported rises. Among those showing declines were autos, chemicals, electrical equipment, oil and steel.
