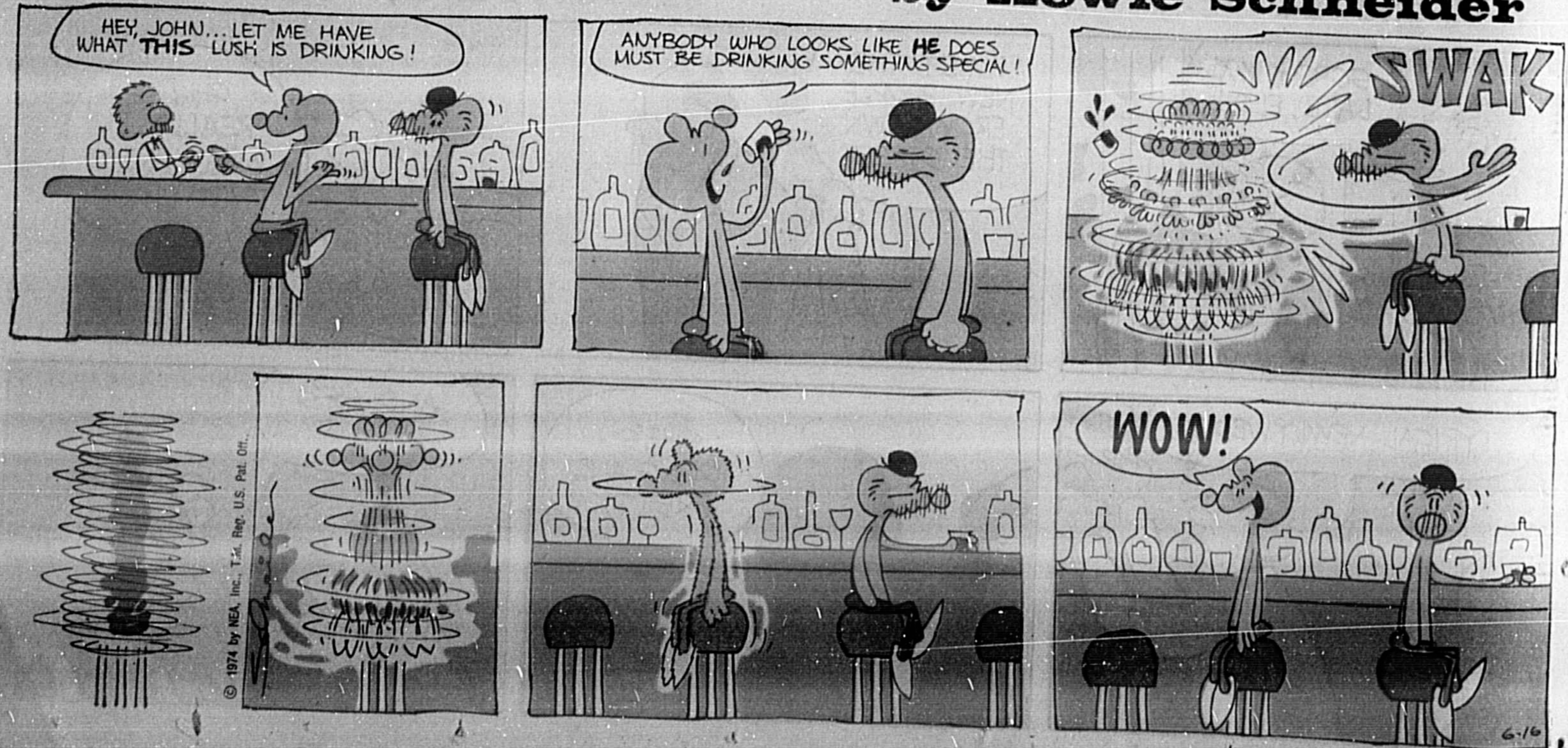

U.S. Adds Nuclear Power For Israel

JERUSALEM (AP) — The United States today helped Israel build a five-megawatt research reactor in 1959 south of Tel Aviv and signed an agreement then to cooperate in the research program. Israel has a second reactor on the Negev Desert that can produce plutonium.

States" to provide electricity for Israel's rapidly growing economy, the communiqué said.

Israel has had an agreement with the United States covering joint nuclear research for the past 15 years, and the communiqué said a provisional agreement would be made this month on the further sale of nuclear fuel to Israel.

The wording of the communiqué paralleled that of one three days ago in which Nixon announced in Cairo the United States would supply nuclear reactors and fuel to Egypt for peaceful purposes.

Kissinger also sought to quiet suspicions in Israel and the U.S. Congress that the Egyptians would use the American nuclear aid to produce nuclear weapons. He said the U.S. government would "make doubly sure there aren't any loopholes" in its agreement with Egypt.

The secretary said there never were any such questions about the similar agreements the United States has with nearly 30 other nations until India set off its first nuclear explosion last month. But Kissinger said India's nuclear program was aided by Canada, and Canada's

safeguards are not as good as those of the United States.

The Israeli government has denied repeatedly that it is producing nuclear bombs or warheads. But foreign experts are convinced Israel's scientists and engineers could manufacture nuclear weapons speedily if ordered to do so.

Kissinger Adamant On Threat

JERUSALEM (AP) — Secretary of State Henry A. Kissinger refused today to soften his threat to resign unless allegations that he lied about his involvement in White House wiretapping are proved false.

Kissinger told a news conference in Salzburg last Tuesday at the start of Nixon's trip that he would quit the government unless he was exonerated. He called on the Foreign Relations Committee to re-examine his testimony before it when he was confirmed last fall, and the committee quickly agreed to look into the matter.

White House officials say that is the way Kissinger wanted it. That's the customary place for a secretary of state when the President is attending summit meetings or making state visits. Kissinger has met with the foreign ministers of the countries visited, sat in on Nixon's sessions with his hosts and otherwise kept busy briefing the President and attending to State Department business.

Kissinger took the limelight only once, at the start of the trip, when he started the White House party with his announcement that he would quit if not believed about his part in the wiretapping of certain Washington officials and newsmen.

That story soon died as far as the newsmen were concerned, partly because Kissinger was generally not available to the traveling press corps. This was attributed to the party's busy schedule.

Midway Fire Kills 2; Started By Cigarette

Sheriff's investigators said today a Midway fire that killed two farm laborers early Sunday is believed to have started in a rooming house mattress ignited by a cigarette.

Capt. L. J. Kriz said autopsies showed Joseph Andrews, 54, and Ernest Ralph Campbell, 50, burned to death when flames leveled the rooming house-grocery store-caffe at Beardsall Avenue and Main Street owned by Lemeul Eudell Jr.

Eudell said Andrews, originally from Tallahassee, had rented a room for "a couple of years" and Campbell, from Bamberg, S.C., "had been here for four or five months."

All nine bedrooms on the second floor of the wooden grocery store building were rented, Eudell said.

John Knight and Walter Jenkins were treated at Seminole Memorial Hospital for injuries received when they just before 12 a.m. Sunday. Kriz said Jenkins suffered leg injuries when he jumped from a second story window.

Sheriff's Lt. Harold Smith and deputy R. S. Morton, first officers on the scene, were told two men were in the blazing building and tried to reach a window with a ladder to rescue them. Smith said the heat and flames were too intense for

the officers to get into the building.

Kriz said the fire "definitely wasn't arson" following an investigation by state and county fire marshals. "We believe it started in the rear of the second floor in a mattress ignited by a cigarette," he said.

Eudell said he was in Leesburg getting jobs for Andrews, Campbell and six other men when the fire destroyed the rooming house.

Unofficial estimates of damage ranged to \$75,000 today in the fire that raged nearly four hours before it was extinguished by volunteer firemen from the Midway, Ginderville, Fern Park, Casselberry, Longwood, Altamonte Springs, Forest City and Osteen fire departments.

The bodies of both victims were found by firemen in the front portion of the devastated building. One man apparently fell to the ground when a portion of his room's floor collapsed. The second charred body was found under debris about 20 feet from a stairwell near a wall that did not collapse, officials said.

Around The Clock White-Only Schools Kicked Out Of Parks

WASHINGTON (AP) — Private, racially segregated schools may not be permitted exclusive use of public recreational facilities, the Supreme Court ruled unanimously today.

The court declined, however, by a 5 to 4 split, to rule also that cities may not permit segregated schools to use such facilities in common with public schools.

And the court ruled 8 to 1 that it is constitutional to allow racially segregated private groups other than schools to use such playgrounds and other facilities.

The question was brought before the Supreme Court by blacks in Montgomery, Ala., who have been fighting for desegregation of city parks and playgrounds since 1958.

Justice Harry A. Blackmun, writing for the majority of the court said Montgomery's policy "created, in effect, 'enclaves of segregation' and deprived petitioners of equal access to parks and recreational facilities."

Justice William J. Brennan said he would favor prohibiting "any school-sponsored or directed uses of city recreation facilities that enable private segregated schools to duplicate public school operations at public expense."

But he said he would determine leaving it up to the federal courts in Alabama to favor petitioners to prohibit "all school sponsored and directed exclusive uses" as favored by Justice Byron White and William O. Douglas.

Item... you may have read (in another paper, please) in a bottle-throwing incident here in Sanford over the weekend where some people were alleged to have had a confrontation with the police... and supposedly it was tied-in with the fire-bombings of a month or so ago.

Truth of the matter is... the man being arrested flipped a bottle away in disgust, which landed near the tire of the police car, and broke.

The arresting policeman was standing only a couple feet in front of him at the time. Surely had this individual wanted to hit the policeman from that proximity he could have bopped him right on the noggin (and suffered the consequences later, I might add).

The point being... there was no bottle throwing incident. What prompted the competition to manufacture this story is beyond our comprehension.

High Court Upholds Aid Ban

WASHINGTON (AP) — The Supreme Court today affirmed a lower court decision invalidating a New Jersey law providing reimbursement to parents of children in private schools for purchase of secular textbooks and supplies.

The Supreme Court let stand a ruling by a three-judge U.S. District Court panel that the law was unconstitutional because it violated the separation of church and state.

Chief Justice Warren E. Burger and Justices Byron R. White and William H. Rehnquist said the Supreme Court should have heard the case. Four justices must vote to hear a case before it is put on the Supreme Court's calendar.

Since 1970, the Supreme Court has struck down seven state laws providing financial aid to private schools or the parents of private school students.

Attorneys for New Jersey Education Commissioner Carl L. Marchberger contended on appeal that the New Jersey law was substantially similar to the textbook loan law and different from the measures recently ruled unconstitutional.
