

### AMG Promises Discretion In Destroying Nazi Books

BERLIN — American Military Government officials predict there will be "no book burnings and no witch hunts" in the American execution of the four-power Allied order to destroy German literature of a Fascist, militarist and anti-Democratic nature. The same discretionary policy, they said, would be followed in execution of a companion directive handed down by the Allied Control Authority's coordinating committee to destroy Nazi memoirs and German military

monuments commemorating World Wars I and II. Maj. Gen. G. I. Adeock, deputy to Lt. Gen. Lucius Clay, deputy military governor, as well as other officials pointed out that the orders left much to discretion of the zone military commanders. "And you can count on it," said one official, that Gen. (Joseph) McNarney isn't going to persecute a German for owning and failing to surrender a history of World War I.

JACKSONVILLE, July 26.—(AP)—A housewife in St. Augustine, who paid 98 cents for a pound of butter and then found it rancid, threw it in the storekeeper's face when he refused to take it back. Police picked up two sailors with 300 pounds of sugar, 50 pounds of bacon and five gallons of lard which they were trying to sell from door-to-door. The source of the commodities was not given.

### Why Soldiers Didn't Bring Tropic Diseases Home To States

NEW ORLEANS — If you've been worrying that your Pacific war veteran would spread such pests as Filaria sanguinis hominis throughout your household, you can relax now.

A world authority on tropical medicine says the menace of an exotic epidemic in the United States—although it appeared real enough early in the war—has been virtually eliminated.

In fact, he warns, the greatest danger is that fear of foreign ailments will distract our attention from native maladies which are on the increase.

"For example," says Dr. Ernest Carroll Faust, parasitologist and head of the Tulane University department of tropical medicine, "there is a persistent increase in the south of murine typhus, which is transmitted by fleas harbored by rats. That is more of a menace to us now than most of the diseases from India and the Pacific will ever be."

Thousands of people have gotten a laugh out of that, but perhaps Russian authorities are not so anxious to have Russian citizens know much about capitalism.

Life In 1936

Civic leaders in Cleveland, which is celebrating its 150th birthday, have put their heads together to envisage their city 100 years hence. For a reporter on The Cleveland Press, they forecast a city of 200-story buildings and downtown parks; use of atomic power, with no smoke or gasoline fumes; jobs for health and longer life; more education and less prejudice; a six-hour day and four-day week, with earnings worth ten times present income in real value; fine homes where the increased leisure is enjoyed, and no slums; and a city that may sound like a dream, but the men looking to the future point out that in the first 150 years Cleveland has grown from a handful of surveyors landing at the mouth of the Cuyahoga River on Lake Erie, to a great center of commerce, trade, industry and the arts.

Box Car Shortage

Scarcity is a mild word for the freight car situation according to figures compiled by Railway Age. The railroads are about 7,000 cars short a week. It isn't that the railroads haven't tried to get more cars. But the equipment manufacturers, inundated by orders for 55,000 freight cars and 813 locomotives, not to mention the passenger cars, are victims of the common production ailment—lack of materials. The factories, after turning out only 50 percent of their possible production, are so short of steel that they are unable to work as usual.

program, or (b) that the commodity is needed to make Great Britain self-sufficient.

Because of the many expenses facing the British government today, there is marked worry in London, as in many capitals, over American price inflation. It makes the dollars they are borrowing worth less because they can buy less.

There is a Bureau of Labor Statistics figure which illustrates British worries: It averages out the price increases during the past year on 28 basic commodities (such as wheat and cotton) to those 12 months, their prices have jumped 5.6 percent. Turn that around and it means that a dollar a Britisher might have received a year ago when he bought a bushel of wheat would now buy only 94.4 cents.

The fact that the dollar has suddenly lost 5.6 cents of its value will add to British "hoosiness" as a buyer, much as the American buyer is beginning to be choosy. The British are likely to jump bargains in countries where prices are lower. In many such cases they'll pay in American dollars. Then the second country will have American dollars to spend here. In other cases, American sellers stand to benefit, since almost every country right now has pressing needs for some American machinery and fuel.

Around the Circle For example, if Great Britain decides to buy Egyptian cotton rather than American, and chooses to pay in American dollars, then Egypt will have dollars to buy most of their wheat in Canada. They probably will, since Canadian wheat can be sold for less than American, then Canada will have more dollars to spend 200,000,000 will eventually come winging home to pay for commodities from American farms and factories.

Every part of the world contributes to the world's supply of raw materials for the United States. In America's bathrooms, you'll find blue tin obtained from Norway, Sweden, Finland and Canada; manganese for black comes from Brazil, Russia and India; chrome for pink, green and maroon is imported from Rhodesia, and iron from Russia.

Any British importer who wants to buy in the United States must explain his purchase to the Board of Trade. If the board decides either (a) that the purchase is something the British should have even under their "austerity living" program, or (b) that the commodity is needed to make Great Britain self-sufficient, the government will approve the deal. The importer will get American dollars to pay for his purchases here.

### Yale Men Get Charge Out of Corn

NEW YORK—Discovery of electrical energy in kernels of corn that predicts whether the corn will

germinate well is reported in the proceedings of the National Academy of Sciences by Dr. H. S. Burr and Oliver E. Nelson, Jr., of Yale University and the Connecticut Agricultural Experiment Station.  
Corn that germinates well contains more electrical energy than other kernels. Good germination insures a better crop.  
This high electrical energy was found also to be transmitted by heredity in corn. Because of this

heredity, the report said the electrical measurements might prove to be a useful tool for plant breeders.  
Much of America's high yield of corn comes from hybrid plants (crosses of two types of corn). The hybrids tend to lose their productivity after a time, so that breeders are trying continually to develop new and better hybrids. One of the breeding problems is to predict in advance how well a

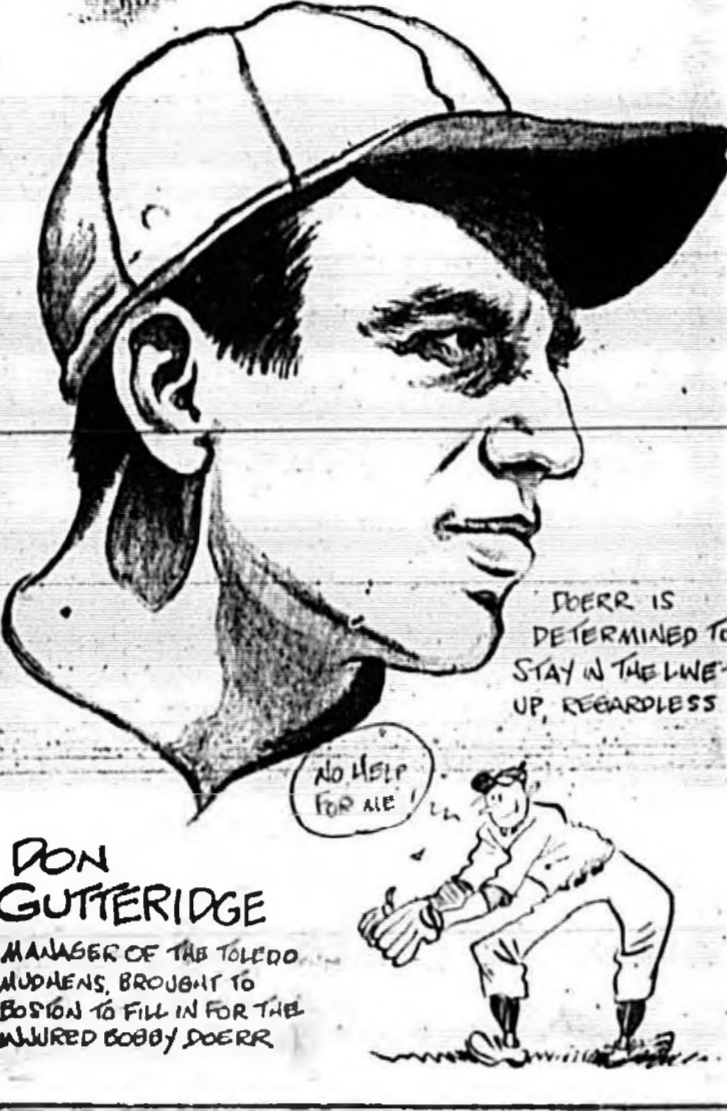

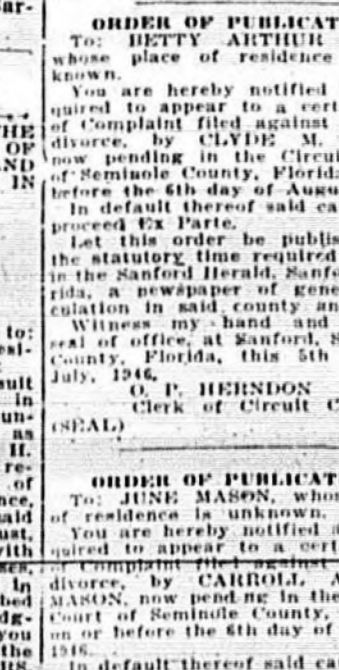
