The "poor little me" school of thought rapidly is becoming passé, however, as the ratio of wealthy widows grows steadily in the population of the United States. It is pointed out by Wilma Soss, assistant of the Federation of Women Shareholders, that every other woman in the country is a widow at the age of 60, and if she doesn't know how to manage her money, she'd jolly well better find out.

Sniff And Chew Business Going Up In Smoke Puff

NEW YORK (AP)—So far no American child has been known to enter this world with a smoker's cough.

The average intelligent child isn't born puffing on a cigarette, a pipe, or a cigar.

One reason is that at that age the child isn't sure just which of these cloudy avenues to throat health is the smoothest, mellowest, mildest, and most flavor satisfying. Some infants have even been known to prefer milk.

But sometimes between the twilight of puberty and the onset of Social Security the average American man or woman, takes up the habit-forming weed, in one form or another.

The form in which he does finally embrace tobacco determines the pattern of a great American industry, a business once built on a sniff and a chew and one that now goes up in smoke.

Snuff has become mainly a rural delight. Chewing tobacco is for the rugged individualists who will swallow their pride and stick by their eul even though union charlatans refuse to correct their errors at the cusplur.

But the sniffers and the chewers are in the minority today. The big race for the tobacco dollar is among the puffers—the cigarette, pipe and cigar smokers.

The cigarette smokers lead by far, of course. But the pipe manufacturers, whose sales fell from \$3,700,000 in 1948 to \$22,500,000 in 1950, are striking back. They want to get their share of the market again.

Speakeading the drive is 37-year-old Morris Levinson, Yale Law School honor graduate and president of the Kaywood Co., which manufactures about 40 per cent of the pipes sold in America each year.

"This year we expect to do about \$24,000,000 in the industry," he said.

"We figure we lost business because the cigarette manufacturers advertised more. So we are advertising more too. And we are emphasizing the same health theme as they do—'guard your throat.'"

He has the reasonably theory that a good \$5 pipe is as gentle to a human throat as a package of cigarettes. (No one smokes for fun any more. The idea is to puff something that won't hurt your throat so much—even if your throat doesn't hurt anyway.)

Some nine per cent of American smokers puff pipes solely, some 17 per cent mix pipes, cigars and cigarettes.

Prestige pipe smokers include Milton Berle, Bing Crosby, Senator Paul Douglas of Illinois, U. S. Steel tycoon Ben Fairless, Herbert Hoover, F. D. Roosevelt, Jr., and the late poetess Amy Lowell, a robust lass, who, alas, also enjoyed a good Havana cigar.

"We are also stuck with Joe Stalin and Tito," said Levinson, fringing, and then added, brightly:

"But pipe-smoking certainly has not hurt their health."

"There are about 120 pipe clubs in the country, including two all-women clubs in New York state.

"Ten years ago we put out a special pipe set for women. It featured six different colored stems to match their dresses.

"We're still trying to find a way to get more women to smoke pipes."

However, 37 per cent of the nation's pipes are sold as Christmas gifts—and women buy 70 per cent of these. So the industry has to sell the ladies.

The word heard is applied, in addition to rattle, to whales, porpoises, swans, cranes and curlews.

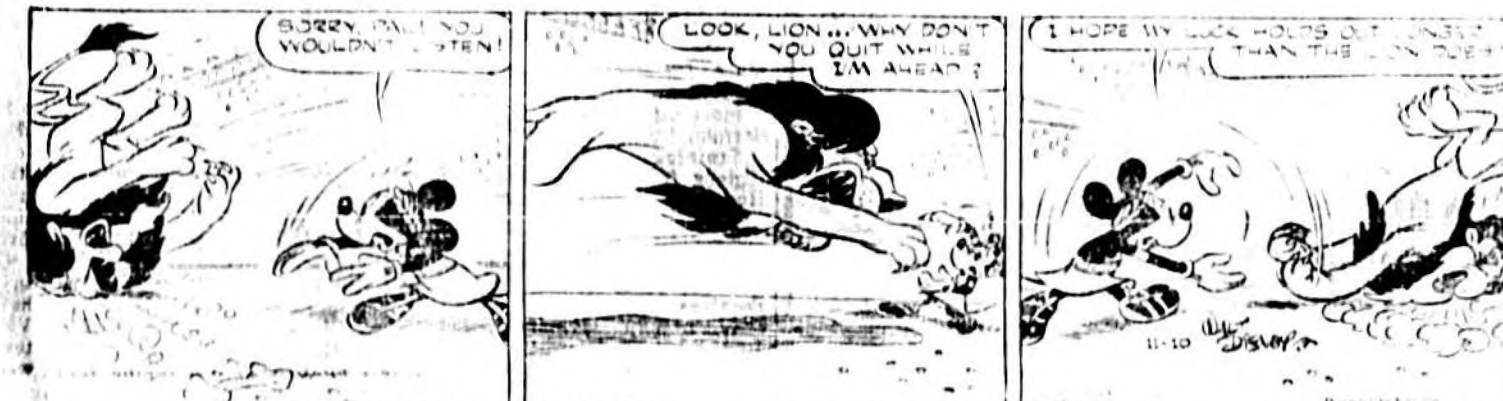

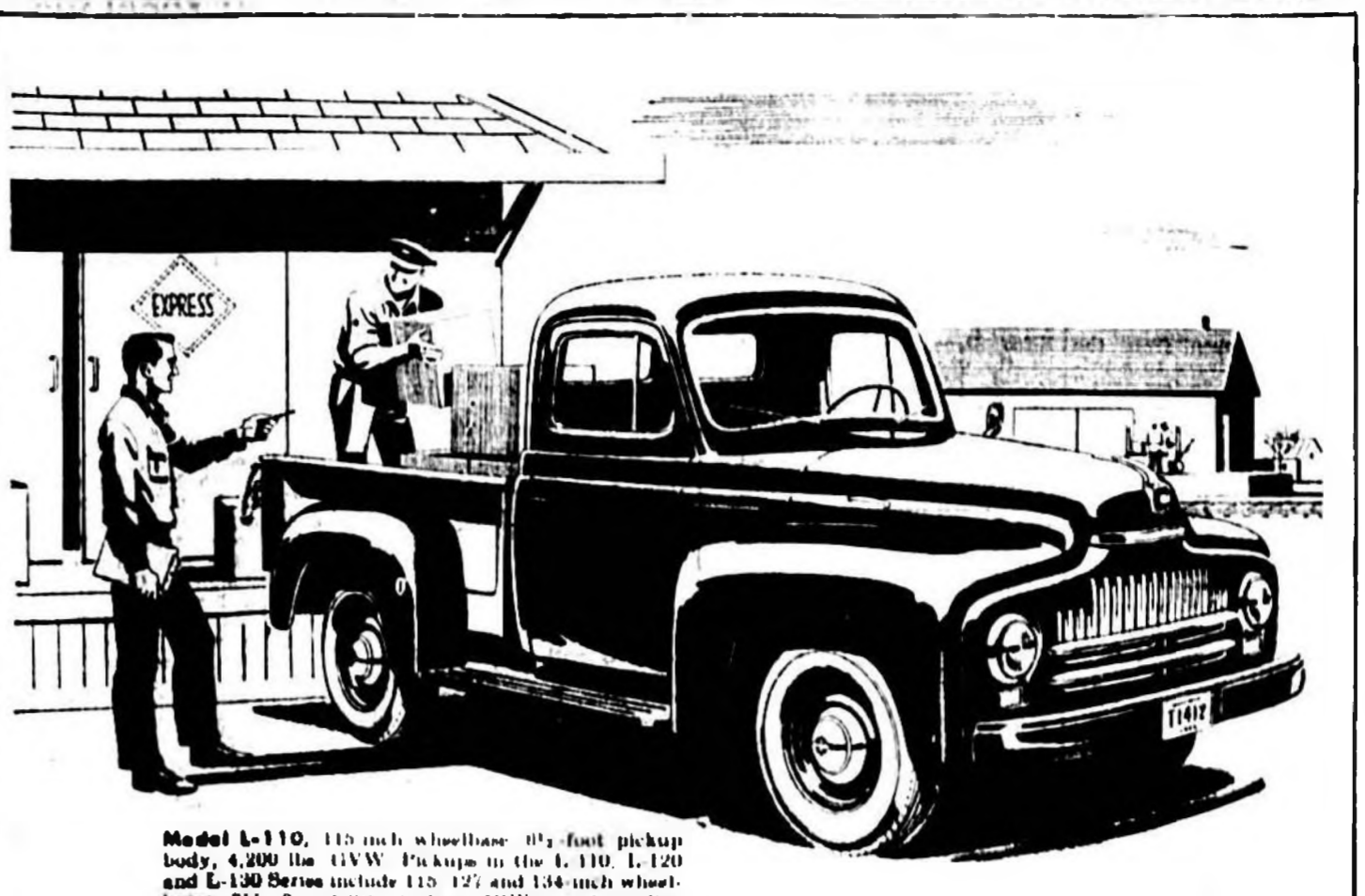
