CONSERVATIVES

All But Will Include the Cabinet and All the Under Secretaries

LONDON, Oct. 16.—Conservative members of the government summoned to meet today to decide whether they shall continue their support of coalition under the leadership of Lloyd George. Meeting not only will include conservatives in cabinet, but also under secretaries belonging to the party.

MANCHESTER, Eng., Oct. 16.—Premier Lloyd George dear with hisosis which Near Eastern crisis has forced upon the government his characteristic and powerful speech in the city of his birth Saturday afternoon. While he spoke as liberal as liberal and chose a city remote from the capital for staging his speech according to the long custom of British statesmen, he was test speaking primarily to Manchester's conservative Boston and the like.

The prime minister's speech was clearly aimed at fully justifying the course of the war. He did not dare to defend it, but he did not apologize for it either. Mr. Lloyd George takes the view that he gave him plenty of opportunity to do so, however, in his speech at Liverpool, when he told the people of that port that the war was being fought "for the freedom of the world."

What the creation of a coalition

government means to the Conservative Party is not clear. Mr. Lloyd George makes no secret of his desire to have plenty of supporters in the new government, but he does not say exactly what he means by that.

I cast my vote against the government because I have never been satisfied with the way in which it has conducted the war. The half dozen or so men who are now in the cabinet are not fit to be leaders of the country. They are not fit to be leaders of the British Empire.
