# There's More To Mexican Cooking Than Tacos, Tamales

When most of us think of food from our Southern neighbor, Mexico, we tend to think that Mexican cooking is nothing but tacos, tamales and chili con carne.

In reality, the Mexican kitchen is rich in tradition, the mingling of Spanish and Indian cultures in a harmonious unity. The "stout Indians" were not too stoic to appreciate good food. In memoirs left by a soldier of the conqueror Cortez, Bernal Diaz del Castillo, he tells of one of Montezuma's dinners that served 300 different plates of meat at just one meal!

The Spanish invaders delighted in those gastronomic luxuries and eventually added their own ideas.

Long before Europe discovered the delights of such foods as cocoa, corn, cinnamon, nutmeg, and the tomato, they were in wide use throughout Mexico. From the humblest peasant home to the grandest hacienda, strange and unusual combinations of fruits and vegetables, combined with exotic spices, brought forth dishes to please the eye and excite the palate.

Another aspect of Mexican cooking is its diversity. In each section of Mexico you will find an entirely different type of menu, much like our own United States, where different regions have their own special dishes.

Now that tamales and tortillas are at hand in so many of our cities and small towns, and that our so often maligned mechanical civilization has brought masa (moist meal for making tortillas) and chile powder and hot peppers and so many other Mexican essentials to our doors, many delicious Mexican meals are available for our enjoyment. Moreover, Mexico has combinations of even our most familiar products which are new and strange, but delectable to the taste buds.

Don't let the newness or strangeness blind you to the delights of Mexican cooking. TOLLUCA SOUP (SOPA TOLLUCANA)

**Copycat Cooking:**  
**Vanilla Marrons**  
1 pound (about 32) fresh chestnuts  
2 cups sugar  
1 cup light corn syrup  
1 teaspoon vanilla

On the rounded side of each chestnut with the tip of a small sharp knife, make two shallow cuts in the shape of a cross through the outer shell and the inner brown skin.

Into a large heavy saucepot turn the chestnuts; cover with water. Over medium heat bring to a boil; boil 1 minute. Remove from heat. While still hot, remove one chestnut at a time and with the help of the small sharp knife, peel off the shell and inner brown skin. If skins become hard to remove, bring water in the saucepan back to a boil to heat the nuts.

Turn the peeled chestnuts into the clean empty saucepot; cover with fresh water. Cook over medium heat, covered, just until tender - 15 to 20 minutes. With a large slotted spoon, remove carefully to drain.

In the clean empty saucepot stir together 1 cup of the sugar, the corn syrup and 6 cups water. Cook over medium heat, stirring constantly, until sugar is dissolved and mixture boils. With the large slotted spoon, gradually add the chestnuts so the syrup does not stop boiling. Boil gently, without stirring, for 1 hour. Let stand, covered, at room temperature for 24 to 48 hours.

Bring the chestnuts in their syrup to a boil. Add the remaining 1 cup sugar and gently stir it in. Cook, without stirring, over medium heat for 30 minutes. Reduce heat to low and cook 30 minutes longer - temperature on candy thermometer will reach 220 degrees. Remove from heat. Gently stir in vanilla. Ladle hot mixture into hot sterilized jars, seal according to jar manufacturer's directions. Makes four 1/2-pint jars. For a stronger vanilla flavor, on opening a jar, add a little vanilla.

Note: Although the chestnuts should be cooked through before they are added to the syrup, they should not be overcooked - this way they have the best chance of staying whole.
