'Boil water' order lifted

MIDWAY — Local residents can drink fresh tapwater again today.

Wednesday, the Seminole County Public Health Unit removed a nearly three-week "boil water" order made after road crews turned off the community's water system Nov. 6. Health officials feared harmful bacteria could escape into the main water line along State Road 46 through leaks. The leaks were repaired last week by road crews paid by the Florida Department of Transportation.

John Cochran, director of the environmental health section, said eight water samples retrieved from Midway between Monday and Tuesday showed no contamination Wednesday. As a result, the boil water notice was lifted immediately, he said.

Christmas tree sale

The Seminole Pony Baseball league will have Christmas trees for sale beginning Saturday. The sale, a fund raiser for the group, will be held at the Five Points Complex on Highway 419, just east of 17-92.

Trees are North Carolina white pines, sizes 7 to 8 feet, at \$5 per foot.

The tree sales will be 9 a.m. until 9 p.m. Saturdays, 1 p.m. until 9 p.m. Sundays, and weekdays from 5 until 9 p.m., until all trees are gone.

The sale starts Saturday, Nov. 30.

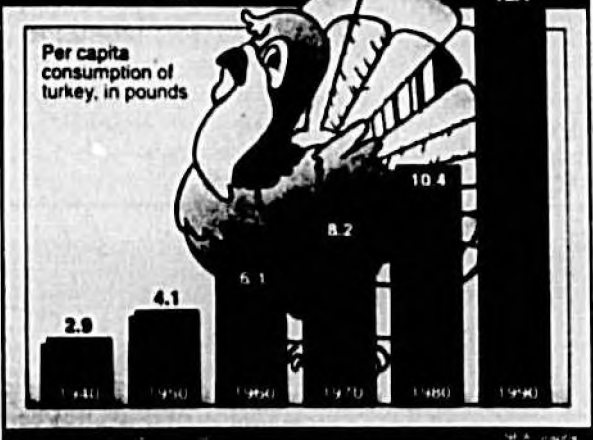

'Stars' in their eyes

Extras preview movie filmed in Old Sanford

SANFORD — Memories are good, a widowed Harry Sultenfuss tells his 11-year-old daughter, Vada, in the movie "My Girl." Many area residents who appeared in the film, agree.

Prior to opening night Wednesday at Litchfield Cinemas in Lake Mary, about 25 people, extras in street scenes, were invited to preview the film as guests of theatre manager Sharon Peters.

"Are you stars ready?" Peters queried. Credits rolled. Music from 1972, the year in which the movie is set, played. A pubescent Vada Sultenfuss burst onto the screen, hopped on her bicycle and headed for the fictional downtown Madison, Pa., which is really First Street in Sanford.

"Oh!" the small crowd gasped with recognition.

"There's Rick!" someone called in the dark.

"There's Judy!" someone else excitedly said.

"I saw us but they cut our heads off," Gloria Jordan said of the pedestrian scene in which she acted with her husband, Guy.

Filmed this past February, Old Sanford was chosen for its charming small-town feel and its splendid Victorian homes. Area residents re-

Husband-wife team shows art

SANFORD — Award-winning artist Bettye Reagan will team up with her husband, Don, for the First Street Gallery's first duo-exhibit. The display is in keeping with the tradition of the St. Lucia Festival.

The exhibit, called "Tandem. Times and Turning," will be dedicated on Dec. 6, from 5 to 8 p.m., then be open to the public the following week.

Bettye will be displaying a number of paintings related to the early Swedish settlers brought into the area by General Henry Shelton Sanford in the early 1970's. The art work will include scenes of early Seminole County, the first school house, and immigrants along the shores of Lake Monroe.

In addition to the Sanford area, paintings also deal with Lake Mary, the Wekiva River and Oviedo. Bettye Reagan's grandfather, Andrew Aulln, was one of the founders of Oviedo, and named the city.

Don Reagan, who took up wood turning only two years ago, uses local woods to create sculptured

700 enjoy 'great' meal served at Crooms School

SANFORD — The cafeteria at the Crooms School of Choice was alive with activity Wednesday afternoon.

Staff members bustled from the kitchen to the serving line with food, others filled Styrofoam plates with turkey and ham, green beans, collard greens and cranberry sauce. Bread overflowed from baskets and cakes and pies were plentiful.

Students eagerly waited to serve the 700 guests who were

invited to partake in what may be one of the few hot meals some have had in a long time. However, not all of the guests were homeless and down on their luck.

"This is great," said Marvin Ealy of Sanford. "It's a great chance for the homeless and the needy to get a good meal."

Ealy said he is not homeless, he is staying with a friend. He is, however, unemployed and things are tight for him.

The students, faculty and staff at Crooms, along with a host of community volunteers put on a

Expressway: Judge rules state liable for damages

SANFORD — The Seminole County Expressway won an important decision from Seminole County Circuit Judge C. Vernon Mize Jr. this week.

Mize ruled Tuesday the authority would not be liable for any damages caused property owners by their land reservations placed on their property by the authority in October 1987, said expressway attorney Lonnie Groot. Mize, in an oral ruling, decided when the state took over control of the 12-mile tollroad project earlier this

year it also took over any liabilities, Groot said. "We'll get to keep our furniture," said a jubilant expressway director Gerald Britton, arms upraised.

The authority currently has no assets other than furniture since it gave the expressway

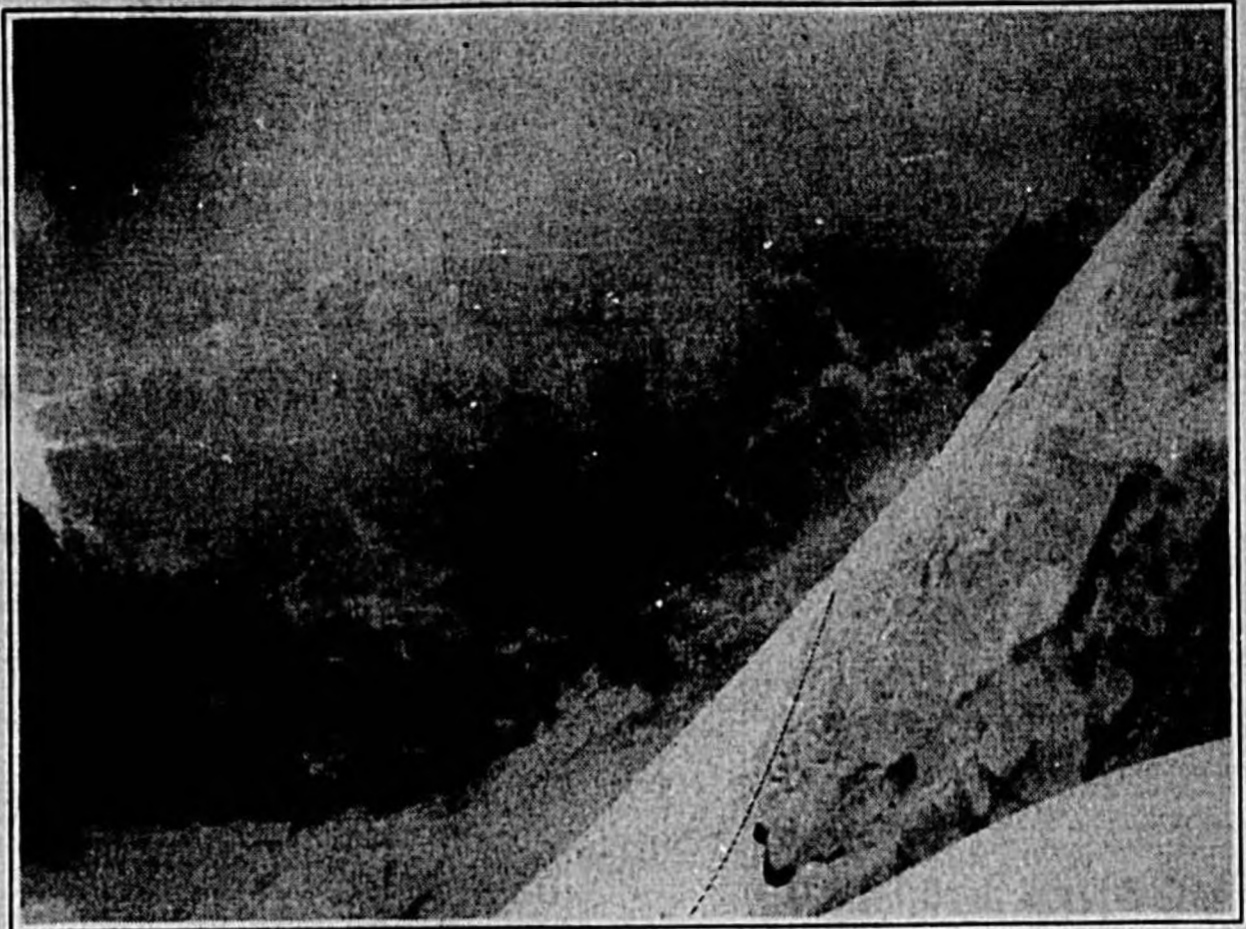

project and existing toll plaza to the state in return for forgiveness of loans and assurances of future loans.

The Aug. 26 lawsuit against the Florida Department of Transportation sought to protect the expressway authority against the dozens of damage claims arising from the authority's reservation of property in the tollroad's path. Expressway officials feared the claims, if successful, would run into amounts they wouldn't even declare publicly.

The reservations were made in 1987 utilizing an existing state law. The law allowed any road-building agency to reserve land for up to 10 years future road construction. The law didn't require the agency to purchase the land until needed during the 10-year reservation period.

The Florida Supreme Court ruled April 26, 1990 such reservations were unconstitutional because they amounted to a taking of property without any compensation. Many of the expressway path landowners claimed they were unable to sell their homes because of the reservations. Groot said.

But FDOT attorneys responded to the claims by saying they didn't put the reservations on, the authority did, so they were not liable to damage claims. Attorneys for the property owners said they didn't care who was liable for the claims, although they preferred an agency with assets.

Groot said the FDOT responds to the claims were made without authority knowledge.

"They started it," Groot said. "They answered in that manner unbeknownst to us."

Florida's Turnpike attorney Steve Tabano was unavailable Wednesday.

Treatments available to help hiatal hernia

DEAR DR. GOTT: My doctor says I have a hiatal hernia. He gives me antacids that do no help. What other treatments are available?

DEAR READER: Hiatal hernia is a weakness of the ring of tissue where the esophagus joins the stomach. Ordinarily, this ring prevents backwash of irritating stomach acid into the esophagus. In patients with hiatal hernia, gastric acid enters the esophagus, causing heartburn, indigestion and gas. This backwash is called reflux; it is a common condition in older patients. Antacids, by neutralizing stomach acid, often help symptoms. Other therapy includes changing eating patterns (remain upright for at least 30 minutes after eating and eat smaller, more frequent meals). Also, medicine — such as Tagamet and Zantac — suppresses the production of acid, thereby relieving indigestion. In extreme cases, doctors may have to consider surgery to repair the hernia. However, non-surgical treatment is usually satisfactory and operations for hiatal hernia are rarely performed.

WIN AT BRIDGE

By Phillip Alder

Bridge is a difficult game because one is operating with incomplete information. If one only had Superman's X-ray vision, it would be much easier.

Today's hand was played in an English tournament in 1964. Cover the East and South cards. Defending against three no-trump, you lead the spade four, partner puts in the 10 and South wins with the king. Now comes the diamond five; three, king, ace. East continues with the queen, ace and six of spades, declarer winning the last. What do you discard?

Passing out one spade would have been reasonable, but even in those days everyone hated to sell out at the one-level, so North balanced with two diamonds. Maybe South should have settled for two no-trump, but often one can make three no-trump with only 22 or 23 points when one knows where the missing honors lie.

When West led his spade four, East's play of the 10 followed the "rule" of conceding a certain loser as quickly as possible. The declarer had seven sure tricks: two spades, three hearts and two clubs. Clearly the diamonds had to be established, but without letting East get the lead twice, first to establish his spades and then to cash them.

On the low diamond lead at trick two, if West put in the queen, declarer could play low from the dummy, so West had to play low. Dummy's king was put up, losing to East's ace. East continued with three rounds of spades. Now West should have seen the importance of discarding the diamond queen, which defeats the contract. But he wasn't willing to throw overboard his only winning card.
