Groups that will sing include the Famous Florida Jubilee Singers of Orlando, the Celery City Quartet of Sanford, the Sanford Jubilee Singers, the Sanford Spiritual Singers, James Hall, Jr., and his Metropolitan Chorus, and Eddie Givins, tenor soloist.

Favorite numbers will be sung and reserved seats are available for white people.

R. E. Kipp, principal of the Sanford Grammar School will be

guest speaker on the program. The Hopper Academy is one of the few Negro schools in Florida which are fully accredited by the State Department of Education for 1941-1942, but has received notice from the department that if it is to remain on the fully accredited list it must add at least 900 approved books to its library.
