It looks as if the Philippine Islands achieved their independence from the United States just in time for the revolution.

When Wendell Wilkie wrote his book on "One World" he apparently hadn't taken the Russians into consideration.

We don't know who is to blame for the present impasse on OPA legislation, but it strikes us some new faces all around wouldn't hurt any.

The Russians have accused the British of being behind a "yellow curtain." Probably because in matters of diplomacy they wear kid gloves instead of brass knuckles.

A Pennsylvania town has a pecking patrol. Now the girls have to look out for the arm of the law.—St. Augustine Record. They need another string to their bow.

Democrats in Congress are having an awful time trying to decide whether they will lose more votes trying to help the farmer raise the price of food, or voting to help the working man reduce the cost of living.

Gene Talmadge says there'll be no negroes voting in Georgia elections for the next four years. Well, if he doesn't keep that campaign promise any better than others he has made, the colored folks haven't anything to worry about.

We hear people speak of inflation in this country, but we don't know nothing yet. In Hungary, for instance, the pengo, their unit of currency, was worth about one-fifth the U. S. dollar just before the war. Now one dollar is worth 800 quadrillion pengoes, and that in anybody's language is a lot of pengoes.

The Deland Sun News reports that oil drilling has been going on in Volusia county near Deland for the past eight weeks, but still nobody seems to know very much about it. The whole affair is all very secret and it is what is known as a "wildcat" operation, but something big may come out of it within another month.

Going far beyond anything we have ever said about him, exceeding even President Roosevelt's apt characterization of "a chronic liar," Senator McKellar of Tennessee says Drew Pearson of Washington Merry-Go-Round fame is "an unmitigated liar and mercenary money-making crook." That should just about cover the situation.

Although James Carmichael received a slight plurality in the Georgia election, despite Talmadge's election by the county unit system, it may be safely assumed that Carmichael received the bulk of the 135,000 negro votes. And if these are subtracted from his total of 314,000, the result shows that among white voters Carmichael received 179,000 votes; Talmadge, 304,000.

It isn't difficult to imagine the hue and cry of 100,000 or more jobless, moneyless refugees were to be sent to any one country. The Palestine Arabs are raising such a cry, only vastly more bloodthirsty, right now. The Jews continue to be the pathetic victims of all this. But it does seem a little unfair to make the British the only villains of the piece.—Fort Myers News Press. One way for the U. S. is to insure justice in Palestine is to accept some of the responsibility.

A former sheriff of Marion county has been convicted on three of four counts in connection with lottery operations in that county. The public by participating in lotteries makes possible such law violations as have brought about the removal and conviction of the Marion county sheriff. Many otherwise Christian citizens, who wouldn't think of doing anything to bring disgrace to their fellowman, buy lottery tickets, little realizing that they are paying the way for someone to go to jail.

Poliomyelitis

In spite of its current prevalence in Florida, the death rate from poliomyelitis (infantile paralysis) has had a distinct downward trend during the last 35 years, interrupted only by periodic epidemics, according to the Metropolitan Life Insurance Company. "Girls have benefited more than boys from this improvement in mortality among white children," reports the Metropolitan. For the period 1911-15, the death rates for both sexes at ages 1 to 14 were practically identical. By 1941-45, the death rates for the girls were only half those for the boys, the rates being 1.1 and 2.2 per 100,000, respectively.

The Thinking Man

When Byron Price, who went from the Associated Press to be director of censorship during the war, made the recent Phi Beta Kappa address at Harvard University, he said that only the thinking man can save us. "What we have in this country today is a national scene of confusion, hesitation and reviving bigotry; of legislative lethargy, timidity and neglect; of economic strangulation at the ruthless hands of marplots; of futile operations in the black market; of increasing juvenile delinquency; of padded relief roles, while work waits for millions; of waste and profligacy in a world of dire need."

**Need Is Stressed For Safety Plans To Cut Accidents**

safety campaign of paramount importance at this time: 1) a new crop of drivers, and 2) a crop of old cars. There are many autos on the highways today, he said, that should not be operating at all, and their owners are reluctant to spend money on them because they are old cars and their owners are hoping for new ones.

Referring to a report of the National Traffic Safety Council which made a survey of 176 cities about the size of Sanford, he said that Sanford ranked 96th from the standpoint of safety records and reports, 84th from the standpoint of traffic engineering, 70th from the standpoint of enforcement, 0 (zero) from the standpoint of school safety, and 78th from the standpoint of public education.

Speaking of youthful drivers, he said there are five times as many accidents among drivers 20 years of age or younger, than among drivers 45 years of age or older. The chief problem in enforcement, he explained, is the problem of obtaining competent traffic officers at a wage which the city can afford to pay. The three Es of Safety he gave as Engineering, Education and Enforcement.

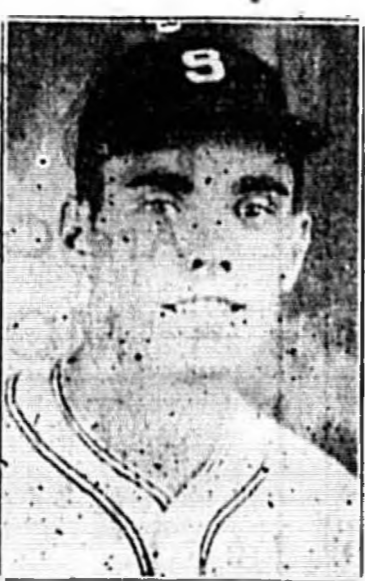

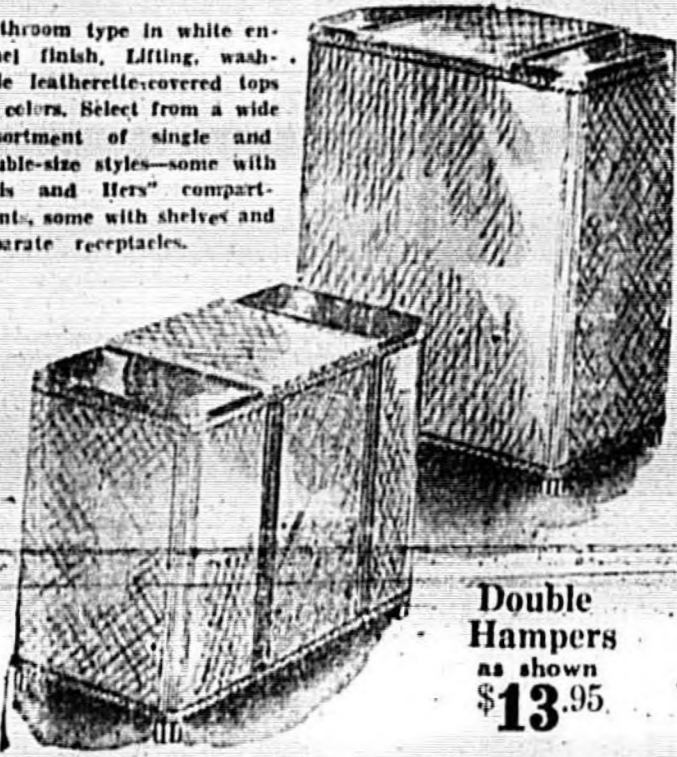

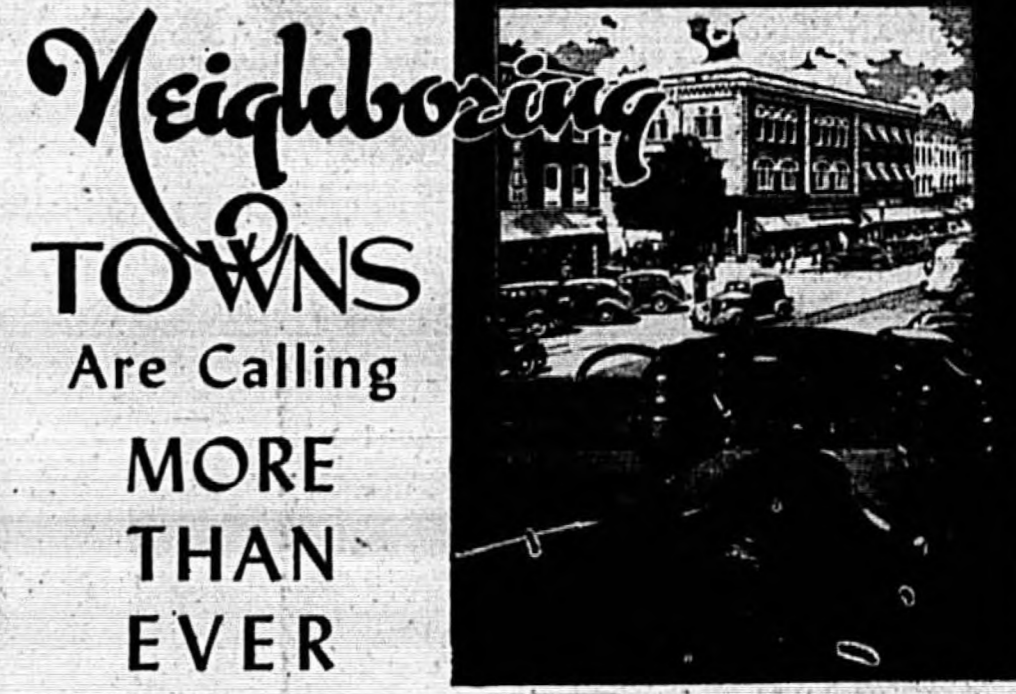
