**White House Mail
Clerk Admits Theft**

WASHINGTON, May 26.—William Buckley, mail clerk at the White House, admitted yesterday to stealing money from white house visitors and sentenced to six months in jail.

Police Lieutenant Major John P. O'Farrell, of the U. S. Secret Service, said Buckley admitted to taking one dollar daily during a two-month session. In addition, he was sentenced to serve 30 days in the executive office of the postmaster general.

Buckley, 35, was arrested last month in Washington, D. C., and was held in custody until his trial. He was released on \$5,000 bail.


During his confinement he was questioned by agents of the FBI and the Secret Service.




