Federal Civilian Employees To Top 3-Million Mark

WASHINGTON (AP) - The rising number of federal civilian employees probably will pass 3 million this month despite cost-cutting orders issued by President Johnson.

Executive branch employment totaled 2,986,136 in June, according to the Congressional Joint Committee on Reduction of Nonessential Federal Expenditures. That represents a rise of nearly 500,000 employees since Johnson took office in November, 1963, and is the highest on record except for during and after World War II. Some of the June rise was seasonal and temporary. The joint committee noted about half the 74.6% increase over May resulted from temporary summer jobs under the President's Youth Opportunity program. There also were seasonal hiring rises at the Interior, Agriculture and Post Office departments.

Administration officials conceded privately there is little possibility of any significant job cutback even though Johnson has announced efforts to curtail spending by as much as \$4 billion under the "cut, tax and borrow" program he sent Congress last week.

The outlook is for rising employment officials said, because only a relatively small portion of federal spending is "controllable" by the administration and because almost all non-defense programs are controlled or controlled in part by Congress. Summer jobs for slum dwellers, youth activities, working programs and other efforts to alleviate poverty are viewed as top priorities.

The joint committee's figures do not include the judicial and legislative branches or the Government Printing Office and the General Accounting Office. The latter agencies are in the legislative branch and their payrolls are outside the President's control, but together account for about 160,000 employees.

The Civil Service Commission, where reports are issued promptly, has issued its report. The report shows the legislative branch total is 840,000 employees, including the GAO and GPO, and judicial branch employment, at 5,967.

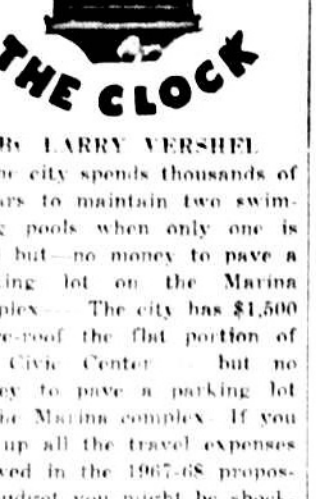

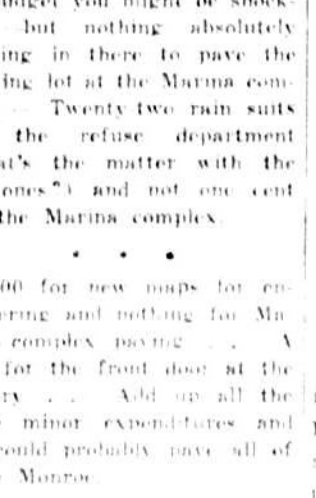
