## NCAA Cracks Down

HOUSTON, Tex. (AP) — Paul F. Dietzel, once the coach of national championship caliber football teams, faced severe National Collegiate Athletic Association restrictions today in rebuilding the University of South Carolina's athletic program.

The NCAA Council Sunday put South Carolina on probation for two years, banned its football and basketball teams from post-season competition and denied it participation rights in the collegiate body's lucrative television program.

The council alleged the school violated NCAA principles governing academic standards and financial aid. It said four basketball players and three football players were involved.

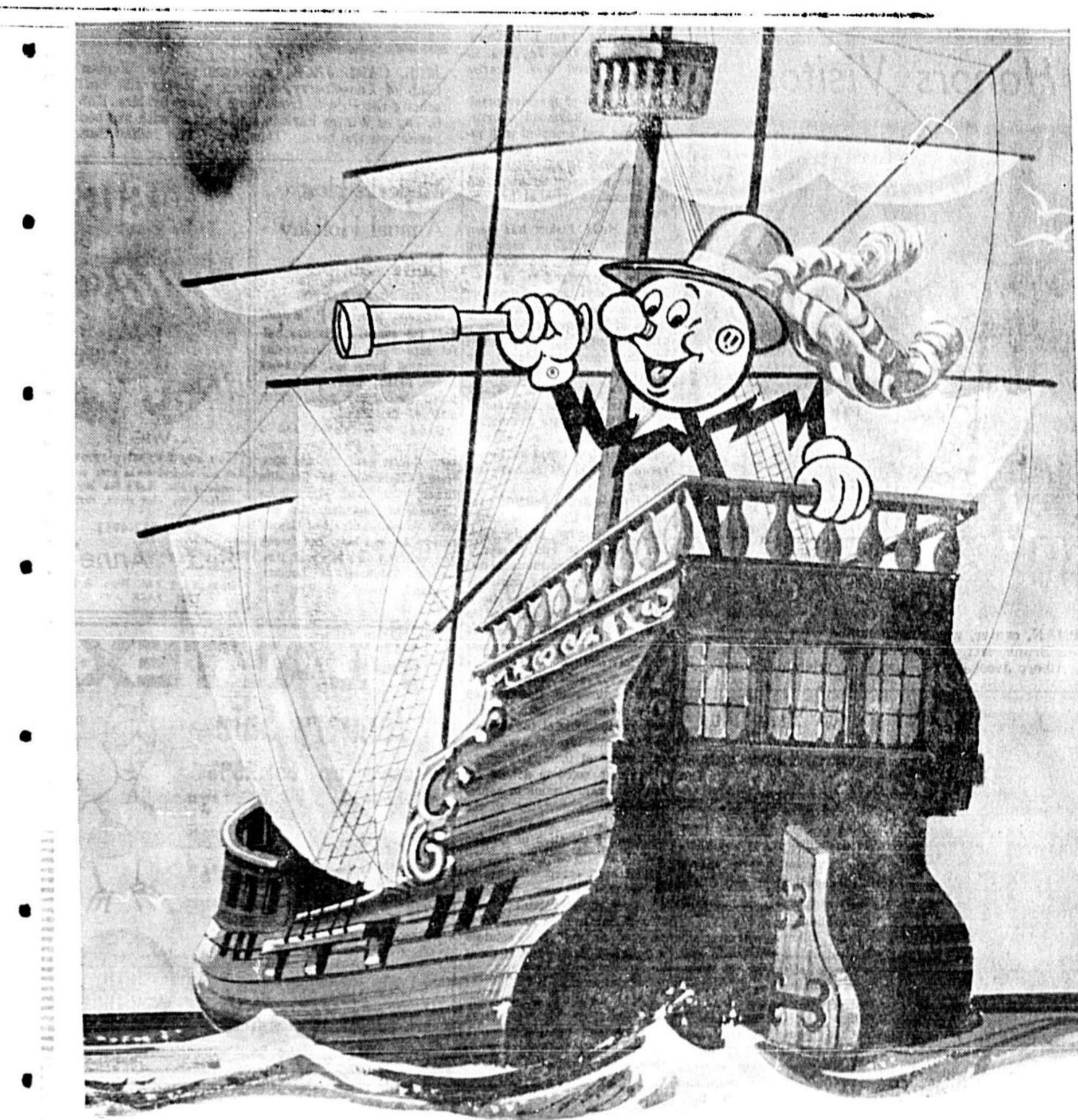
