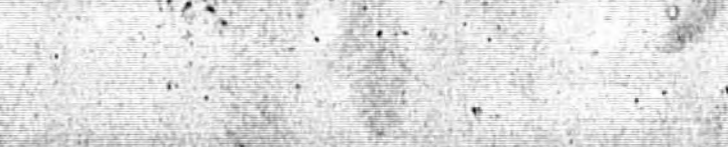

Our military forces cannot take any chances on weakness of numbers, in view of the large part of the Japanese Army which must still be defeated.

Dr. Fu Manchu is dead. This fiendish Chinese villain will never again carry out devilish plots with the aid of strange poisonous reptiles from Burma, or futher, an unknown gorilla-like apes from Abyssinia.

This information comes from Sax Rohmer, the novelist who has chronicled Dr. Fu Manchu's spectacular history. He killed his creation off at the request of the Chinese government, who felt that too many readers and movie fans would assume all other Chinese to be equally diabolical.

3 U. S. Armies Are Linked In Front East Of Rhine

Continued From Page One

PARIS, Mar. 28. (AP) American and British forces poured in a torrent across the plains of middle Germany last night through demoralized Nazi resistance.

The entire front was abuzz with the fires of victory as Allied divisions and armies vied with one another in the wild dash eastward from the Rhine toward Berlin, less than 237 miles away.

Partial censorship shrouded the extent of the sensational Allied advances, but the enemy radio said U. S. Third Army columns were approaching Wuerzburg in Bavaria, 223 miles from Berlin.

Third Army doughboys were fighting in the heart of Frankfurt on the east side of the Main River after charging across a damaged railroad bridge in the face of blustering machinegun and mortar fire.

The Allied-controlled Luxembourg radio said that Wiesbaden, four miles west of Frankfurt, had been captured.

North of Brunen, British Second Army forces were reformed, smashing eastward almost unopposed, with censorship, hiding their exact movements.

U. S. Seventh Army moved its long drive northward from the Mediterranean by making two crossings of the Rhine.
