64 Per Cent Of All Receipts At Race Tracks For Taxes

MIAMI, Mar. 23, (Special)—Sixty-four and one-half cents of every dollar collected from horse racing in 1944 at Hialeah Race Course went for taxes, it is revealed by figures compiled for the new booklet, "Racing at Hialeah." The state took 52 1/2 cents, the federal government 10 1/2 cents, and the county and municipality 1 1/2 cents from every 100 cents spent at the track, statistics show. "The belief not infrequently expressed that Horse Race Tracks are getting rich is not in agreement with the facts, at least not in Florida where the state's tax is greater than anywhere else in America," says the booklet. Florida's pari-mutuel tax for share of the "take-out" is eight percent in contrast to six percent in New York; five percent in Arkansas, California and Washington; four and one-half percent in New Hampshire; four percent in Rhode Island, Louisiana, and New Jersey; three and one-half percent in Delaware and Massachusetts; three percent in Oregon; two percent in Illinois and Maryland, and one percent

### Pfc. Wilcey Sipes Is With "Powder River" Division

WITH THE FIFTH ARMY, ITALY, Mar. 2 (Special)—Pfc. Wilcey J. Sipes, son of Mrs. Lenora Hodges of Sanford, is a member of the 91st "Powder River" Division signal company, which recently has been maintaining wire communications along Highway 65, main gateway into Bologna, Italy, in the face of German shellfire.

The company entered the line on the Fifth Army front to participate in operations bridging the Arno River. Since then it has laid more than 2000 miles of wire along the Florence-Bologna traffic artery and delivered more than 50,000 messages.

Working conditions going forward have often been harassed by machinegun fire from straggling German planes and the wire frequently locate and eliminate ruptures in the lines while nearby doughboys nestle deeper in their foxholes for protection during German shell concentrations.

Booby traps, mines and time bombs are among the hazards the signalmen encounter from day to day, and occasionally they have done their work under enemy small arms fire.

The communications men put a line through Futa Pass from division headquarters to a regimental command post in one of the most severe German artillery concentrations of the Gothic Line fight. The crew voluntarily returned through the same concentration of fire to lay an alternate wire.



Railway Reorganization

3 U. S. Armies Are Linked In Front East Of Rhine

Continued From Page One

PARIS, Mar. 28. (AP) American and British forces poured in a torrent across the plains of middle Germany last night through demoralized Nazi resistance, smashing irresistibly toward a link up with Russian armies in the East.

The entire front was abuzz with the fires of victory as Allied divisions and armies vied with one another in the wild dash eastward from the Rhine toward Berlin, less than 237 miles away. Both the mighty American armies in the center and the British in the north were racing eastward almost unopposed, and a front dispatch declared "The rout is underway."

Partial censorship shrouded the extent of the sensational Allied advances, but the enemy radio said U. S. Third Army columns were approaching Wuerzburg in Bavaria, 223 miles from Berlin and had reached Lehr, 225 miles from the rubble German capital.

Third Army doughboys were fighting in the heart of Frankfurt on the east side of the Main River after charging across a damaged railroad bridge in the face of blustering machinegun and mortar fire. They had a strong holding in the southwestern part of Germany's ninth city, but the enemy still was resisting stubbornly.

The Allied-controlled Luxembourg radio said that Wiesbaden, four miles west of Frankfurt near the confluence of the Main and Rhine Rivers, had been seized.
