





### Circus Coming To Town Friday

Sells & Gray three-ring wild animal circus will exhibit in Sanford on Friday. The traditional "big top" and other tents will be erected for the one-day showing on American Legion Fairgrounds, Highway 17 & 92 South.

Circus spokesmen indicate that this year's edition of Sells & Gray has drawn together top talent from the various European and American Circuses and combined it into the strongest production in the show's 67-year history. Special emphasis has been placed on daring aerial and acrobatic numbers and on animal acts.

Among the headlines on this year's bill are the Jungwies, sensational Austrian performers who have been featured in the major circuses in London, Paris, Rome, Berlin and Copenhagen. In one of their more unbelievable feats, one member of the troupe circles the center ring while lying on his back on a moving electric car. As he travels, he balances a 25-foot unsupported ladder on his feet. Atop this ladder two other troupe members go through a variety of acrobatic stunts, climbing with a head stand. The Jungwieses score the use of nets or safety devices, depending entirely on their own physical skill and co-ordination.

Sharing the spotlight are the Kasse's Performing Russian Bears, massive brutes trained to perform fantastic tricks. Bears are notable for being dangerous and unpredictable animals to work. This does not seem to bother their trainer, young Miss Kasse, even though "Captain," largest of the group, weighs 400 lbs. and towers 45-50 feet when reared on his hind legs.

Other outstanding features of Sells & Gray Circus for 1967 include the Jim Jensen, beautiful young star of the high trapeze; the Droguettes, Spanish jugglers; Vic and Dean Lewis, famous English clown making their first appearance in the United States; Sebastian, the illusionist; the Florida French Fiddle; and Frederick Walton.

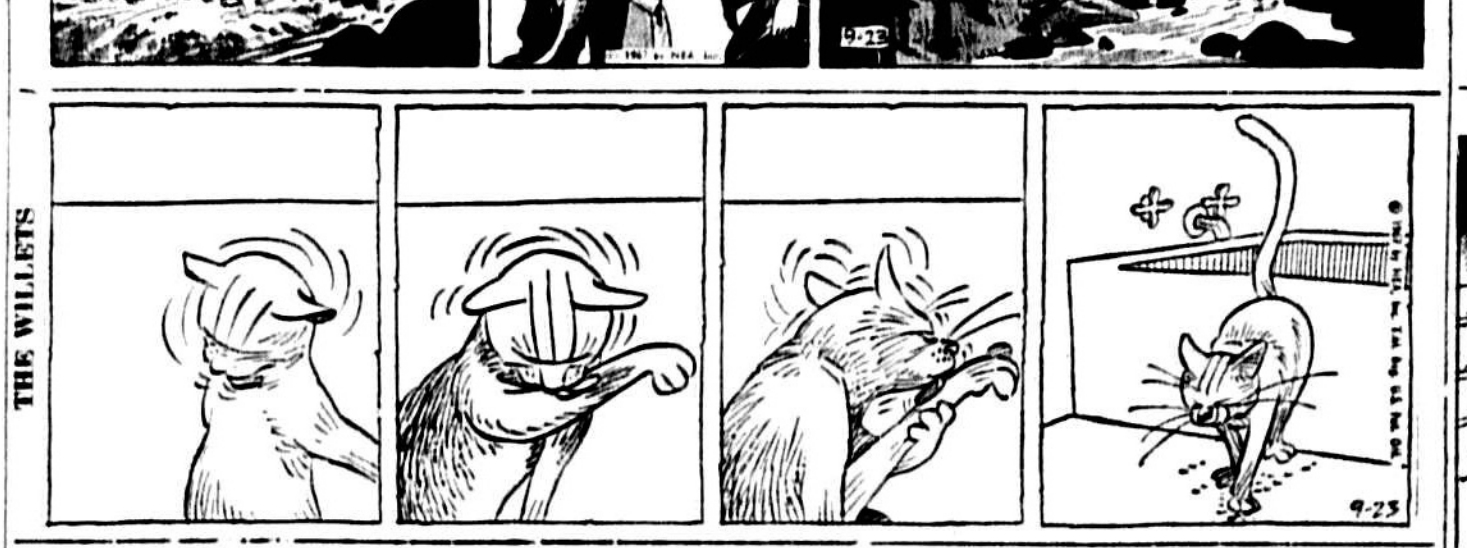

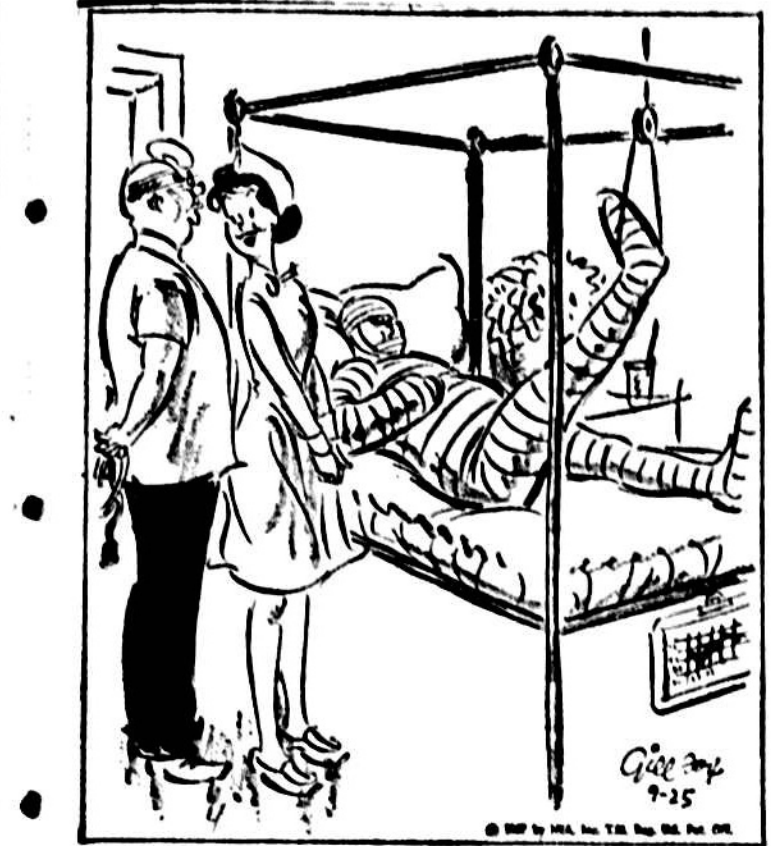

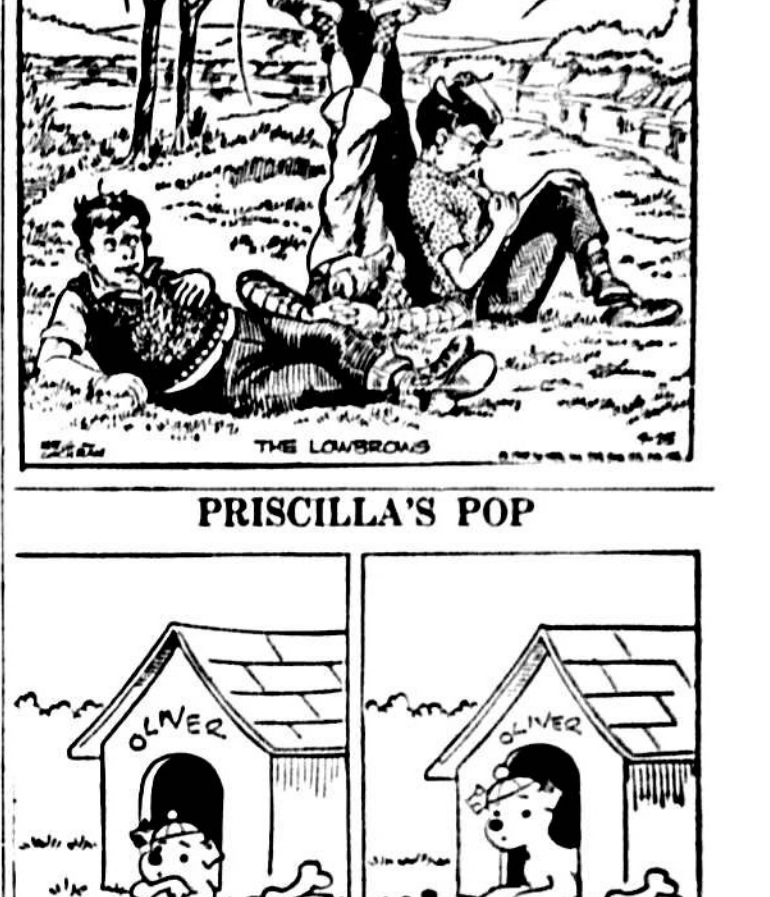
