Sharp Rise Is Noted In Trade With Americas

Latin-American Exports In May Are Nearly Double Figure For Last Year

WASHINGTON, July 8.—A sharp upturn in United States trade with Latin America was noted today.

The increase came at a time when the Roosevelt administration was discussing methods of improving inter-American trade.

Exports to Latin America in May totaled \$7,200,000, the highest figure since 1935, according to a report by the Commerce Department.

The increase was due to a sharp rise in exports of raw materials and agricultural products.

The Commerce Department also reported that imports from Latin America in May totaled \$1,200,000, a 50 percent increase over the same month last year.
