### World Awaits Russian Retaliation To Rebuff In Quest For Dardanelles

ISTANBUL—The world today is waiting to see what Russia will do about its latest rebuff in its quest for the Dardanelles.

"The big danger today," said a professional observer who has spent years at this vital listening post, is that Russia is likely to make the same mistake that it has made twice—too much faith in the reports of agents, not enough in the warnings of govern-

ments. The reports of agents cause war."

This correspondent asked the observer, one of the most reputable in the Near East, if he did not mean "might make the same mistake" instead of "likely." He replied that he felt the situation was enough to justify "likely."

They're Fought 12 Wars

Russia's beating of the drums for possession of the Dardanelles began in the days of Peter the Great and was resumed a year ago last March by Molotov.

In five times since 1688 Russia and Turkey have gone to war over this all-year outlet for Russian shipping.

Now the Turk, backed solidly by the western powers has refused to accede to new Russian demands and has made it plain that he will not hesitate to fight and, perish if he must, before yielding one inch of territorial and sovereign rights over the straits.

Russia startled both Turkey and the democracies by demanding an equal share with Turkey in the defense of the Dardanelles—which would mean Soviet bases on Turkish soil.

Russia also proposed that administration of the straits be handled exclusively by Black Sea powers, a maneuver which would cancel the nine-power Montreux Convention governing traf-
