How I 'Bombed' Fort McClellan

NOTE: The war on terrorism intensified following the mid-air U.S. seisure of four Palestinians wanted in the deadly Achille Lauro raid. How safe is America from retaliation? So far, no major foreign-backed terror incident has ever taken place in the United States.

FORT McCLELLAN, Ala. (NEA) — There is a prominent sign posted on one of the gates to, the military reservation here. It's painted in bold, red and black letters, and it reads: "Warning. All persons, property and vehicles are subject to inspection upon entering and departing this installation.

The sign seems to be forbidding, it's designed to suggest the Army is forever on its toes, but the opposite is true. The Fort McClellan gates are not peopled with sentries most of the time. the sign is the only security arrangement, and no one need fear a search going into the base.

Terrorism, for example. And going to the main gate. there is an increasing threat of it. Fanatics drove a dynamite-laden truck into the U.S. military compound in Beirut in 1983. and blew up 241 Marines. More recently, political renegades stole into an American base in Germany and activated another murderous detonation.

I proved it myself the other morning. I drove on this base in an automobile stuffed with make-believe explosives, and I made the rounds of a terrorist moving without detection. I could have killed dozens of soldiers, or blasted any building on the reservation, and gotten away free and clear.

Here's how.

I struck in the morning, just about rush hour. The security guards were still on duty from give them every chance to stop covered them with a motel and drove into the installation. sheet, and I began my ploy by

I asked the sentry there for directions to base headquarters. He was a well scrubbed towhead, all of 19 or 20, and he said to go by the golf course and turn left. He did not look at the load in my back seat, he was too busy fidgeting with his neck scarf. and he waved me on with an impeccable salute.

I thought, "This is too easy." So I pulled to the side of the entrance to give the guard time to get suspicious. He didn't. He stood stiffly, a caricature of cool, eyes front, feet at ease, face fixed; he might have been waving through an entire convoy of outlaws, thugs and crazy people.

Yet it wasn't his fault. The guards at most U.S. military gates are decorations rather than defenses. He had been trained to the night before, and I wanted to spit-shine his boots, keep a press in his khakies, and look out for me. I put suitcase "bombs" in drunk drivers and druggles; I the back seat of my rental car, I sighed, made a wave of my own

Fort McClellan hosts a school for nuclear, biological and chemical warfare, as well as the military police, but it is small, the population is less than 10,000 at a given time, and the buildings are surrounded by well-trimmed shrubbery and unhurried streets.

I drove down each of the streets. I spent an hour on a tour. I hoped, again, that someone would stop me, and I violated a host of traffic regulations in this regard — but no. I visited the hospital, the PX, the officers billets, even the military police station, and I could not arouse curiosity.

So, I parked at the front entrance to the headquarters building. It is a pleasant, whitewashed structure, with a roof of red tiles. I got out of the car, and set an alarm clock to ring on the dashboard in 15 minutes. Then I crossed the street and took a picture of the scene before the "devastation."

If there had been genuine explosives in my car, they would have detonated at 8:15. If I had been a genuine terrorist I would have escaped by that time. I believe a few hundred pounds of dynamite would have destroyed Nice place, I might mention. the headquarters building and

Art Festival Project To Aid Center


