two later, accordting to the IRS The system works like or her return and takes it to a hiling service to be transmitted via telephone to the
IRS. Or. a professional TRS. Or. a protessional
preparer completes the return and 1 it $e s$ it
electronically, An electronte return usually results in
refund in two or three weeks
The TRS encourages
electronte fiting because it reduces errors and
paperwork. But the agency
is discouraging the re. is discouraging the re-
fund-anticipation loans. which appeal to those who
don't want to watt two or three weeks.
In those cases, the IRS
