

Railways Adherent On Their Stand As To Wage Schedule

CHICAGO, Dec. 21.—(AP)—The adamant stand of the railroads was maintained Monday as their wage conference with union labor leaders started its second week.

For the third time, they refused a proposal of the employees that the present arrangement, involving annual deduction of \$200,000,000 from pay checks, be extended for another year after it expires Jan. 31.

For the third time, the roads said the deduction was inadequate, and that their own offer of a six month extension was "as far as we are warranted or justified in going."

Fifteen hundred shopcraft leaders from every part of the country, anxious to spend Christmas at home, heard the reply of the carriers and then went into separate meetings of their 21 groups.

Arms Embargo Aim Of Message To Be Handed Congress

WASHINGTON, Dec. 21.—(AP)—The administration's interest in the settlement of the undecided Bolivian-Paraguayan war in the Chaco crystallized Monday in plans for a special message to Congress requesting authority to declare embargoes on shipments of arms to countries in which hostilities exist or are threatened.

The message, which was on the President's desk Monday, was understood to have made no particular reference to Bolivia or Paraguay, but sought congressional approval for a future prohibition against arms shipments to any country regarded as a possible or actual threat to international peace.

The United States is a member of the neutral American commission, which, since September, 1931, has been seeking a settlement of the Chaco territorial dispute.

Peace proposals have been offered and accepted by one side or the other in principle, but hostilities have continued.
