A man found on the palace grounds was detained for questioning, but the News said he was not believed to have any connection with the diplomatic burglary.

No member of the royal family was in the palace at the time. King George VI is shooting game birds at his country estate, Sandringham, in Norfolk county.

The News said the diplomatic box was found by a sergeant in the Irish Guards. Noting that it bore the initials "G.R."—short for George Rex, the Latin for King George—and a crown, he reported the discovery to the police.

Scotland Yard was called in, the News said, and soon established that the box had been stolen from Salisbury-Jones' room at the palace. The News added that the box, which had been locked, had been smashed open and a part of the contents removed.

The room where the theft occurred has two big windows, ten feet from the ground. It is immediately in the right of the ambassador's entrance to the palace. If the thief went in that way, he passed within 150 feet of the sentries on duty outside the main gate.

The News said the box was last seen, locked and intact, in Salisbury-Jones' room at 5 P.M. yesterday.

Wage Increases And Rising Wool Costs To Advance Price Of Suits

NEW YORK, Oct. 13—(AP)—Men's clothing workers are getting a pay boost of around \$5 a week next month—as they start work on your next spring's suit.

It's bound to cost you more to get in the Easter Parade, clothing men say. And it worries them. Some think you may be wearing fewer all-wool suits in the future—and more made all, or in part, or synthetic.

Perhaps only 30 per cent of the expected price hike of \$5 to \$10 a suit will be due to rising labor costs, suit makers say. World wool shortages and defense stockpiling plans will take a heavier toll of your pocketbook.

The price of raw wool has gone to record highs in Australia. The world is consuming more fine apparel wool than it is producing—cutting away the last of the stockpiles built up in World War II.

Now the U. S. government is conferring with Australian and British, trying to get the Australians to let us have first pick of around 1 1/2 million bales of wool for defense stockpiling.

The clothing trade notes that defense stockpiling would cut available world supplies that much more—make competition for the remaining wool that much keener—and the price of raw wool that much higher. Naturally, they add, the government should certainly have a sure supply of wool at hand to clothe its defense forces. But they say the threat of U. S. stockpiling probably was behind last month's rise in world wool prices.

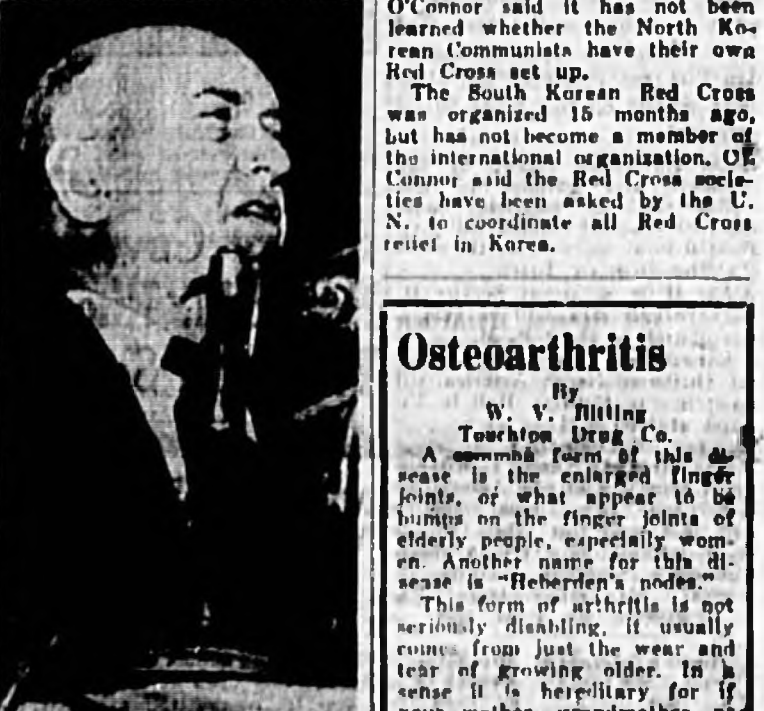

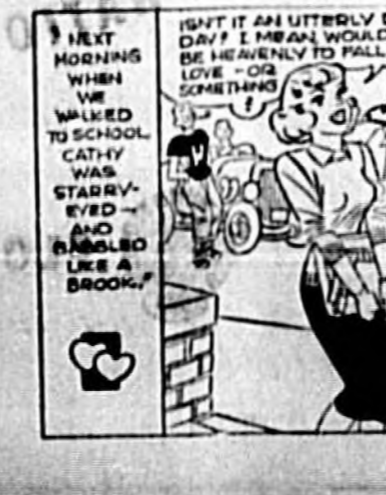
